

Erosion and Sedement Control Schedule

A stone access drive complete with under lying geo-textile fabric (20 feet wide and 50 feet long) for ingress and egress at the site shall be installed. This drive shall be the only entrance

A silt fence shall be installed prior to any earthwork activities at the site in the locations shown on the site plan as well as along the front of any lot that slopes towards the street.

within seven(7) days of completion of intitial grading.

or wetland shall be complete within two(2) days of the disturbance if the site is to remain inactive for longer than

initial grading is complete.

/ fourteen(14) days.

Disturbed areas of the site that are to remain idle for more than twenty-one(21) days shall be properly seeded and straw mulched

Temporary seeding and mulching ao a thirty(30) foot strip of

the entire front of the lot shall be maintained on the site once

Stabilization of critical areas within fifty(50) feet of any stream

Straw-mulch shall be applied at a rate of 1 bale per every ten (10) feet of curb, at a width of thirty(30) feet to the entire length of the lot. Wood chips may also be used but must be spread at a minimum depth of four inches over the thirty-foot width and must be accompanied by a properly installed silt

Erosion and sediment controls shall be inspected every seven(7)
