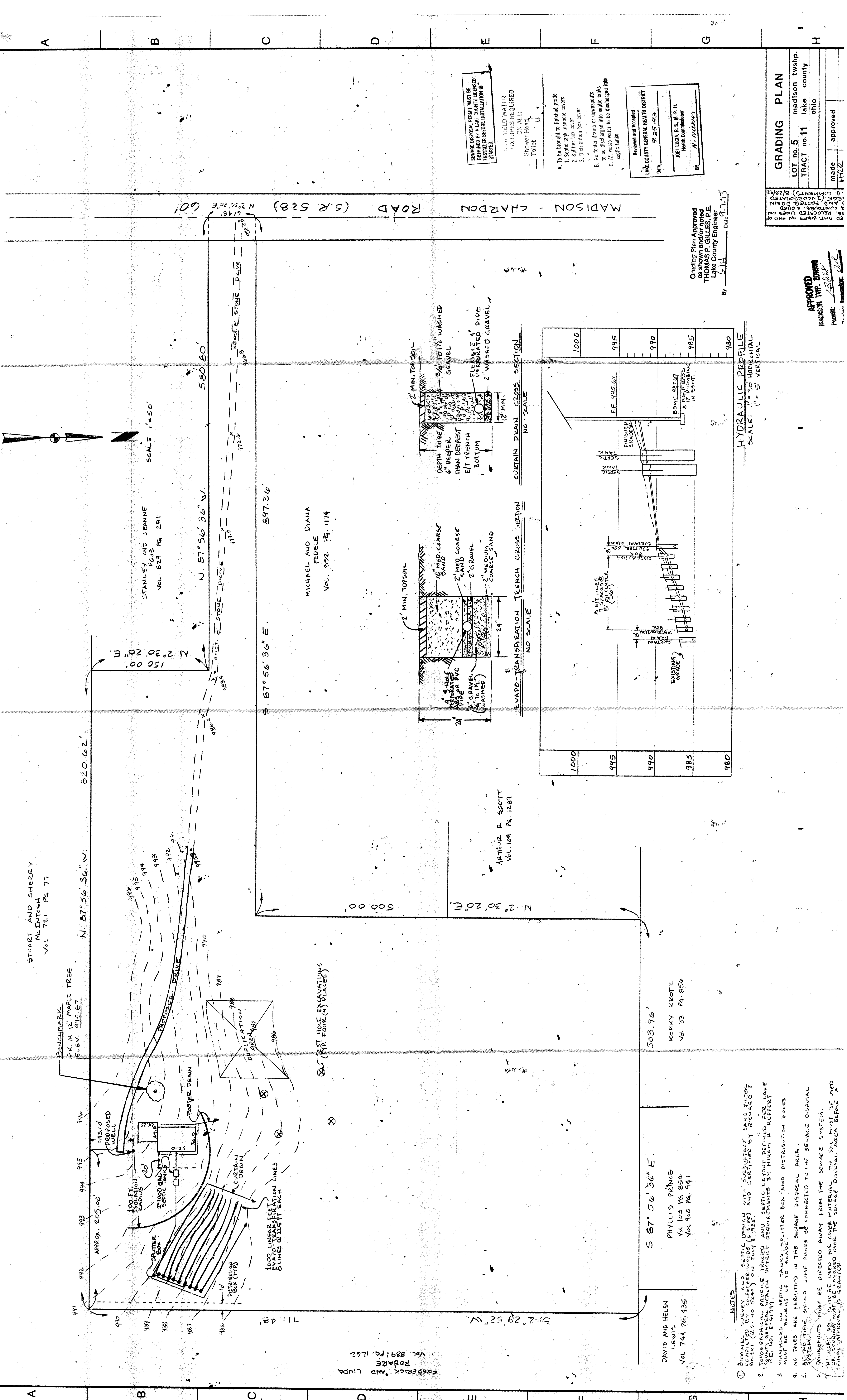




**NOTES**

2. TOPOGRAPHICAL PROFILE TRACED AND SEPTIC LAYOUT DESIGNED PER MAINE COUNTY GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT REQUIREMENTS BY MIRIAM K. REPERT (P.E., NO. E-47191).
3. MANHOLES ON SEPTIC TANKS, SPLITTIER BOX AND DISTRIBUTION BOXES MUST BE BENT UP TO GRADE.
4. NO TREES ARE PERMITTED IN THE SEWAGE DISPOSAL AREA.
5. AT NO TIME SHOULD PUMPS BE CONNECTED TO THE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM.
6. DOWNSPOUTS MUST BE DIRECTED AWAY FROM THE SEWAGE SYSTEM.
7. ONE CUBIC YARD OF SOIL TO BE USED FOR COVER MATERIAL. TOP SOIL MUST BE USED OR COMPENSATION GRANTED OVER THE SEWAGE DISPOSAL AREA BEFORE A FINAL APPROVAL IS GRANTED.

5. AT NO TIME SHOULD PUMP PUMPS BE CONNECTED TO THE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM.

6. DOWNSPOUTS MUST BE DIRECTED AWAY FROM THE SEWAGE SYSTEM.

7. NO OILY RAIN WATER IS TO BE USED FOR COVER MATERIAL. TOP SOIL MUST BE USED OR SOILING MUST BE DONE OVER THE SEWAGE DISPOSAL AREA BEFORE A FINAL APPROVAL IS GRANTED.
