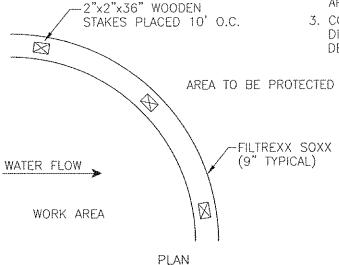

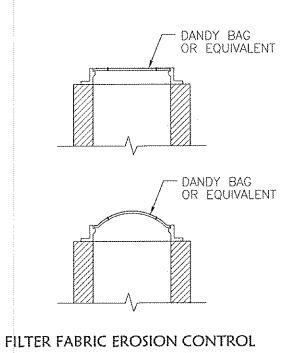

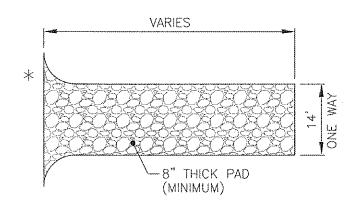

TEMPORARY SEEDING SPECIFICATION



FOR MANHOLES OR INLETS



- 1. THE AGGREGATE SIZE FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE PAD SHALL BE 2 INCH STONE. PLACE THE GRAVEL FLUSH TO THE EXISTING ADJACENT PAVEMENT, SMOOTH IT, AND LEVEL IT AS REQUIRED.
- 2. THE THICKNESS OF THE PAD SHALL NOT BE LESS THAN 8 INCH MINIMUM. USE NON-WOVEN GEOTEXTILE FABRICS TO IMPROVE STABILITY OF THE FOUNDATION. GEOTEXTILE FABRIC SHALL BE TREVIRA SPUN BOUND TYPE 011/250 OR APPROVED EQUAL. IT SHALL HAVE A GRAB TENSILE STRENGTH OF AT LEAST 190 LB, AND WILL BE PLACED OVER THE ENTIRE AREA PRIOR TO PLACING OF STONE.
- 3. THE WIDTH OF THE PAD SHALL NOT BE LESS THAN THE FULL WIDTH OF ALL POINTS OF INGRESS OR EGRESS AND IN ANY CASE SHALL NOT BE LESS THAN 14 FEET WIDE.
- 4. MAINTENANCE THE ENTRANCE SHALL BE MAINTAINED IN A CONDITION WHICH WILL PREVENT TRACKING OR FLOWING OF SEDIMENT ON TO PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY(S). THIS MAY REQUIRE PERIODIC TOP DRESSING WITH ADDITIONAL STONE. MUD SPILLED, DROPPED, WASHED, OR TRACKED ONTO PUBLIC ROADS, OR ANY SURFACE WHERE RUNOFF IS NOT CHECKED BY SEDIMENT CONTROLS, SHALL BE REMOVED IMMEDIATELY. REMOVAL SHALL BE ACCOMPLISHED BY SCRAPING AND/OR SWEEPING.
- PERIODIC INSPECTION AND NEEDED MAINTENANCE SHALL BE PROVIDED AFTER EACH RAIN, OR EVERY SEVEN DAYS.
- 6. CONSTRUCTION ENTRANCES SHALL NOT BE RELIED UPON TO REMOVE MUD FROM VEHICLES AND PREVENT OFF-SITE TRACKING. VEHICLES THAT ENTER AND LEAVE THE CONSTRUCTION SITE SHALL BE RESTRICTED FROM MUDDY AREAS.
