



Survey of $\frac{25}{100}$ acres of land in Lot No. 33 Prairie Tract Unionville Town 11 Range 6 as per order of Co. Auditor given Jan 1870 to Francis Hendry for payment of Taxes and penalty due for the years 1868 & 1869 on $\frac{6}{100}$ acres of land entered for taxation in the name of E. O. Warner in W- part of Lot No. 33 Unionville, in Pain Tract Madison township.

And is bounded as follows, Beginning at a stake in the west line of said Lot No. 33 and $10\frac{1}{2}$ feet from the present south west corner of Titus Gales land, thence with the west line of said Lot No. 33, S. 30° W, 1 chain & 58 links

to a stake, thence parallel with the north line of said Lot 33, S. 88° E. 1 chain + 58 links to a stake one foot west of the foundation wall of A. Grover's house + 5 feet north from the south west corner thereof, thence N. 3° E. parallel with the west line of said Lot 33, one chain + 58 links to a stake on lands of Titus Gale, 10 1/2 feet north of his present south line, thence N. 88° W. one chain + 58 links to the place of beginning. Containing ²⁵100 of an acre, sit as near a square form as may be laid out.
