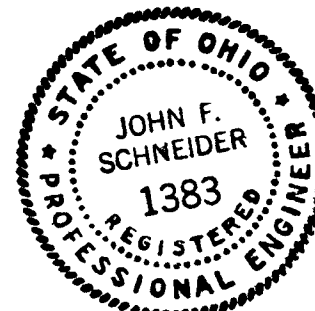


TOPOGRAPHICAL SURVEY

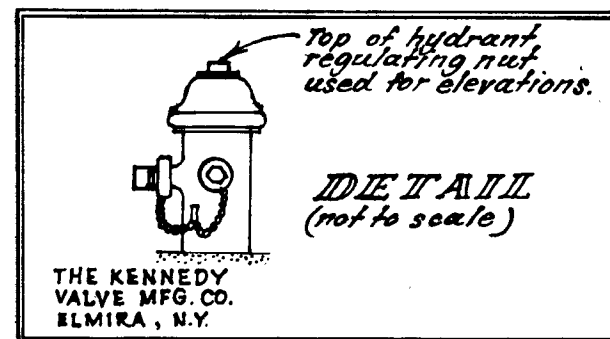

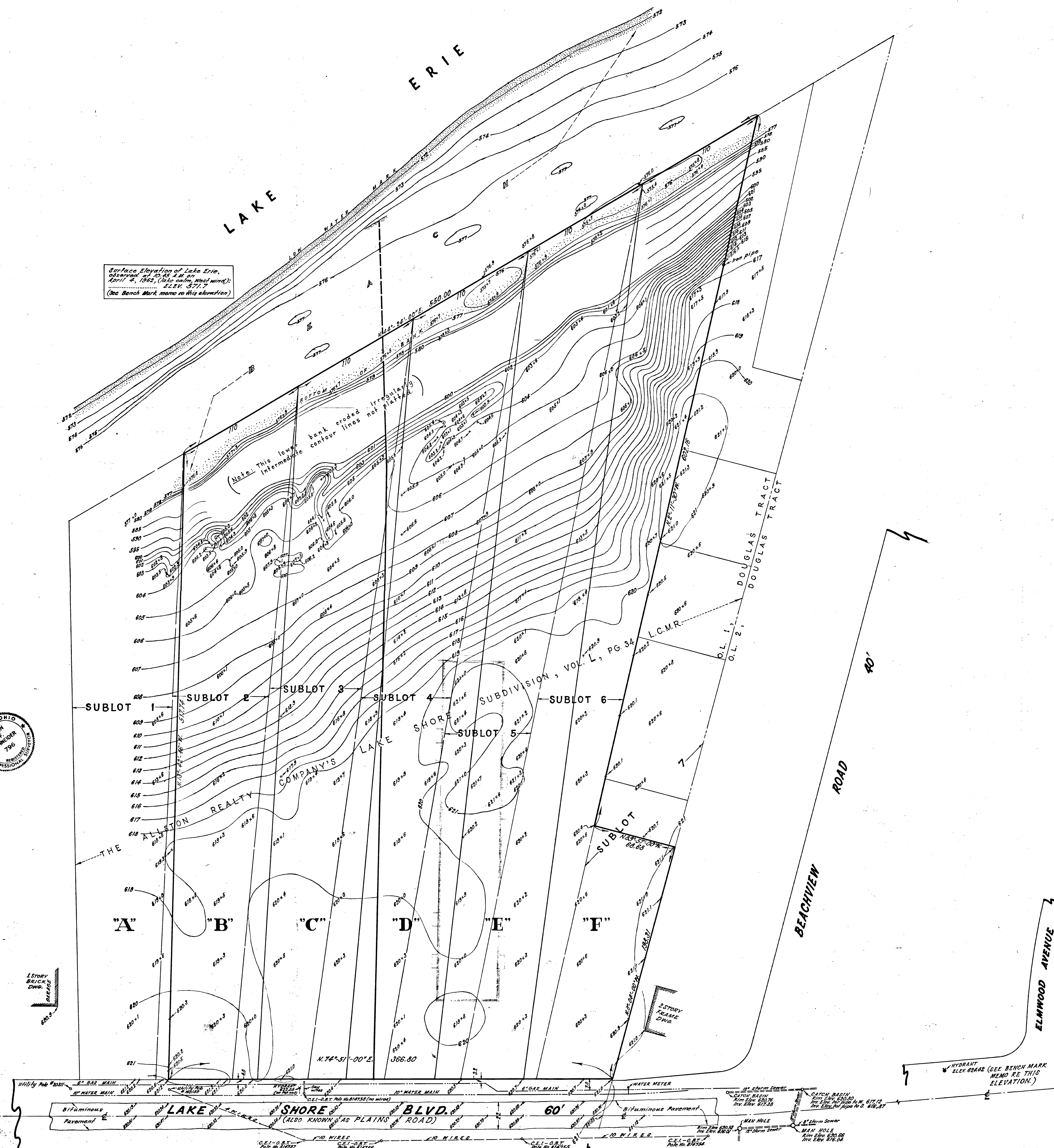

BENCH MARK
 Elevation of top of nut of first water hydrant located on the North Side of Lake Shore Boulevard, just West of Elmwood Avenue (Elev. 624.42 feet above sea level) was established by Fullerton and Kerr, Engineers for the City of Willoughby, Ohio. This observation was based on U.S.G.S. Monument 713-1932-617 per Fullerton and Kerr records.
