

Survey and Plot of that part of the Road in
 Road doesn't No 3 in Willoughby, and on the
 East side of Chagrin River as was destroyed
 by the Wash of the River and bounded as follows
 beginning at a point in the ~~in~~ centre of the
 Road near foil Rivers house and from which
 point a Chestnut tree about three feet diameter
 bears $45^{\circ} 42' N$ distance 97.0 Links thence $41^{\circ} N$ 13 chains
 35 links to a Stake on the division line between
 Roy Corrille & foil Rivers then 162.7 m - 80 chains 2 links
 to a Stake thence $44^{\circ} 45' N$ 100 chains 22 links to a Stake
 thence $62^{\circ} N$ 6 chains 22 links to the centre of the
 Road near the barn on Land owned by the heirs of Thomas
 Gunn deceased
