

C 16024 A.F.E. 1907	Installed Jan 6, 1923	In connection with the reconstruction of Bridge No. 340, East B.W. 2450 + 23.3 the following changes were made: Old masonry arch bridge removed, new east abutment constructed of concrete and west abutment altered for deck plate girder span. 4' deck plate girder 33' long extends from east abutment to concrete pier on stone footing and 8' deck plate girder 62' long extends from concrete pier to west abutment. 8' x 8' safety bay constructed to right of station 2435 + 55.5. Concrete retaining wall 2' wide and 50' long constructed to left of east abutment.
