

TYPICAL SECTIONS ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENT

NOTES

Item E-1 Roadway Excavation and Item L-2 Topsoil Furnished and Placed shall be performed on areas included under Item L-9 Seeding as designated in tables on plan sheets and payment for same to be as set forth in the respective Items

Under Item L-9 Seeding, use commercial fertilizer at the rate of 20 lbs. per 1000 square feet, formula 8-5-3, Commercial Fertilizer #1.

Under Item L-5 Seeding and Renovating Existing Sod, use commercial fertilizer at the rate of 10 lbs. per 1000 square feet, formula 8-5-3, Commercial Fertilizer #2.

Mulching as specified under Item L-18 to be performed over all areas where seeding is performed either under Item L-9 Seeding, or Item L-5 Seeding and Renovating Existing Sod. Straw shall be used for Mulch.

Planting of new trees where shown outside of Right of way shall be performed only where planting permits have been obtained by The State Highway Department.

At planting time, if proposed locations of trees interfere with over-head lines or structures the Engineer may order change of location.

No Cavity work will be required under Pruning Existing Trees, Item L-17.

Planting shall have straw mulching on surface and peat in the bottom of planting holes.

Quantities are subject to revision, and unit price payment will not be limited by G-4.03.

Loosening of subgrade to a depth of three (3) inches shall be required immediately prior to placing of topsoil 4 inch depth.

Sod to be renovated shall be harrowed, disked, or grubbed to a depth of two (2) inches before top dressing with one (1) inch of topsoil.

Mixtures of grass shall consist of the following proportions by weight:

Kind of Seed	Item L-5 Seeding or Renovating existing sod	Item L-9 Seeding
Kentucky Blue Grass	70%	65%
Domestic Rye Grass	10%	20%
Red Top	20%	15%
Rate of Application	2 Lbs per M Sq.Ft.	4 Lbs per M Sq.Ft.
