ROADSIDE REST GENERAL NOTES

ITEM SPECIAL - WELL SHELTER

METHOD OF MEASUREMENT

The well shelter and all appurtenances as detailed on sheet Nos. 130-A, 130-B, shall be considered as one unit. The number of units to be paid for shall be the number of each unit, listed and estimated separately, complete and accepted.

BASIS OF PAYMENT

The work included in this item shall be paid for at the contract unit price bid for each "Item Special Well Shelter" completed and accepted, which price and payment shall constitute full compensation for all excavation and backfill, and for furnishing, hauling and placing all materials, and for all labor, equipment, tools and incidentals necessary to complete this item.

ITEM SPECIAL - PARK TABLE

METHOD OF MEASUREMENT

The park table and supporting slab as detailed on Std. Drwg. R.P.2, shall be considered one unit. The number of units to be paid for shall be the number of each unit, listed and estimated separately complete and accepted.

BASIS OF PAYMENT

The work included in this item shall be paid for as the contract price bid for each "Item Special Park Table" completed and accepted, which price and payment shall constitute full compensation for all excavation and backfill, and for furnishing, hauling and placing all materials, and for all labor, equipment, tools and incidentals necessary to complete this item.

ITEM SPECIAL - BULLETIN BOARD

METHOD OF MEASUREMENT

The bulletin board with all appurtenances as detailed on Std. Drwg. R.P.3, shall be considered one unit. The number of units to be paid for shall be the number of each unit, listed and estimated separately complete and accepted.

BASIS OF PAYMENT

The work included in this item shall be paid for at the contract unit price bid for each "Item Special Bulletin Board" completed and accepted which price and payment shall constitute full compensation for all excavation and backfill, and for furnishing, hauling and placing all materials, and for all labor, equipment, tools and incidentals necessary to complete this item.

ITEM SPECIAL - DRILLED WELLS

(See Notes in Proposal)

ITEM SPECIAL - PRIVY AND STORAGE SHED

METHOD OF MEASUREMENT

The privy and storage shed with all appurtenances as detailed on Std. Drwg. R.P.4A,4B,4C, shall be considered one unit. The number of units to be paid for shall be the number of each unit, listed and estimated separately, complete and accepted. Concrete walks are not a part of this item.

BASIS OF PAYMENT

The work included in this item shall be paid for at the contract unit price bid for each "Item Special Privy and Storage Shed" completed and accepted, which price and payment shall constitute full compensation for all excavation and backfill, and for furnishing, hauling and placing all materials, and for all labor, equipment, tools and incidentals necessary to complete this item.

SEEDING AND PROTECTING

Seeding shall conform to Specifications L-9, except that the areas to be seeded shall be thoroughly loosened to a depth of at least 2 inches and harrowed before seeding. All rough, uneven areas including fencerows shall be graded to eliminate humps or depressions that would interfere with future mowing of the grass with a hand propelled power mower. All stone and debris larger than 2" in any dimension shall be removed from the surface before mulching.

Seed Mixture Shall Be As Follows
45% Poa Pratensis (Kentucky Blue Grass)
35% Festuca Rubra Var. (Illinois Fescue)
20% Agrostis alba (Red Top)

Rest areas, other than the parking lot, shall not be used for storage of materials, parking of equipment, vehicles or for the location of buildings of any kind during construction by the Contractor.

Areas to be seeded are estimated for the entire rest area. Portions of this area may be non-performed at the direction of the Engineer.

LOCATIONS OF REST AREAS STRUCTURES, PLANT MATERIAL AND APPURTENANCES

The location of Tables, Charcoal Grills and Serving Tables, Well Shelters, Privy and Storage Sheds, Bulletin Boards and Plant Material as shown on the plans are approximate only. Exact locations will be determined by the Engineer during construction.

TOPSOIL FOR L-ITEMS

This shall be obtained from stock piles provided for by E-103 (a).

ITEM L-13

Areas indicated on plans for this item shall be prepared as beds excavated to a depth of 18 inches and backfilled with topsoil.

ITEM E-9 REMOVAL OF TREES AND STUMPS

Within the Rest Areas only those trees indicated by the Engineer shall be removed. Care shall be exercised by the Contractor in performance of this work so that no damage is done to trees indicated by Engineer to be saved.

The Rest Areas shall be cleared and grubbed in accordance with Section E-1.03 of the Construction and Material Specifications. Areas under this item are considered to be all rest areas outside of the limited access Right-of-Way.

The average size of trees and stumps and approx. percentage to be removed are shown on the plan. The State of Ohio will not be responsible for any variation found during construction. The lump sum bid for Item E-9 Removal of Trees and Stumps, shall constitute full payment for this item and no additional compensation will be allowed.

ITEM L-17 PRUNING EXISTING TREES

All trees within the Rest Areas that are indicated to be saved by the Engineer, shall be pruned in accordance with Item L-17 of the Construction and Material Specifications. In addition to the work specified above, low limbs shall be removed to obtain seven (7) foot clearance above the ground as directed. Rest Areas are considered to be all Areas outside of the limited access Right-of-Way.

The number and size of trees to be pruned may be estimated from information shown on the plan relative to existing trees and the percentage to be removed. The State of Ohio will not be responsible for any variations found during construction. The lump sum bid for Item L-17 Pruning Existing Trees shall constitute full payment for this item and no additional compensation will be allowed.
