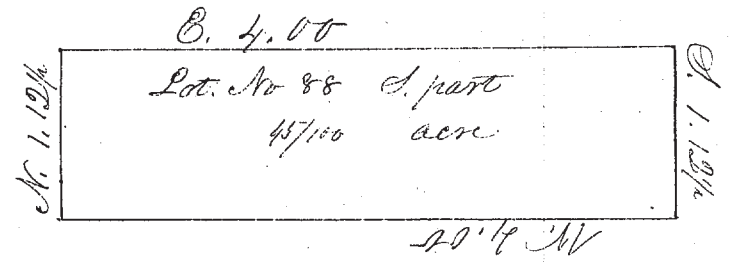


Survey of 15/100 of an acre of land from the south part of Lot No. 88 Merchants Sec. 10 of the village of Millington Gore Range 10. Purchased by Reuben Hitchcock, at a sale of lands forfeited to the State of Ohio for the non-payment of taxes, on the 11th day of December 1843. Bounded as follows to wit, Commencing in the centre of Erie Street fifty one rods south from the south line of the Mirt farm so called; and from which the S. E. corner of Nathan Bushman's tavern house bears North 43 1/2 W. 78 links distant. Thence South along the centre of Erie Street 1 chain 12 1/4 links. Thence N. 4 chains to a post. Thence N. 1 chain 12 1/4 links to a post. Thence E. 4 chains, to the centre of Erie Street, and the place of beginning.



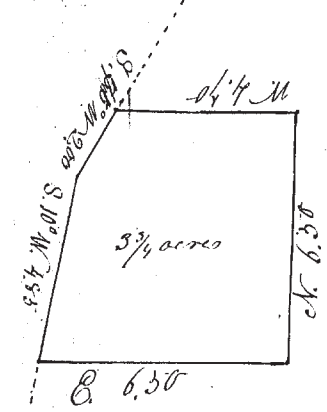

No. 13 } Survey of 3 1/4 acres of land in tract in Township No. 9 in the 9 Range of townships of the Co. of Hamilton of Lot No. 5, sold for taxes in the 27 day of Dec. A.D. 1841 by S. Corning Treasurer of Lake County and bid off by Orrin Wilson. The above lot was charged in the name of Oliver Olney - bounded as follows
Commenced ^{at a stake} at the centre of the road leading from the village of Highland to the Ridge road, at the S. W. corner of Darius Martin's Lot of 6 1/2 acres, being also the N. W. corner of the Olney Lot of ten acres; Thence run N. 30 W. two chains to a stake in the centre of the road; Thence N. 10 W. four chains ^{to} to a stake in the centre of the road; Thence E. six chains ^{to} to a post; Thence N. six chains ^{to} to the N. line of the Olney Lot; Thence W. four chains ^{to} to the place of beginning.
