


No. 15 Survey and plot of the middle part of Lots No. 107 & 108 Star-survey in the town of Painesville - as follows - Commence at the S. E. corner of William Herr's Lot being the N. part of said Lots No. 107 & 108. Thence run southerly on the west line of State Street forty feet to the N. E. corner of Colby & Huntington's part of Lots No. 107 & 108. Thence westerly on the N. line of said Huntington's lot one hundred fifteen and a half feet to the East line of James Roots part of Lot No. 108. Thence northerly on the E. line of said Roots part of Lot No. 108 and parallel with State Street forty feet to the S. line of William Herr's Lot aforesaid. Thence easterly along the south line of William Herr's Lot one hundred fifteen and a half feet to the place of beginning.

No. 16 Survey and plot of the dividing line between Jonathan Harrington and Samuel W. Heath's land in Lot No. 97 in the South Easterly part of the Township of Kirtland, Lake County, Ohio. viz Begun at a point in the N. line of said Lot No. 97 from which a black tree, eighteen inches in diameter, bears N.  $74^{\circ}$  West 29 links distant. Also another black tree sixteen inches diameter bears N.  $54^{\circ}$  E. 50 $\frac{1}{2}$  links distant. Being the place where the original stake stood as the N.W. corner of Jonathan Harrington's part of said Lot No. 97 and also the N.E. corner of Samuel W. Heath's part of said Lot No. 97 - and planted a stake and stone at said point, as the true corner, agreeably to the depositions of Teri Sperry, Daniel S. Sperry jun. and Lewis Sperry. Thence run South  $14^{\circ}$  E. 9 chains 43 links to the centre of the road running from Chardon to Cleveland.

Persons present at fixing said corners and running said line, besides the deponents - John Morse, Daniel Gow, Jenison Clark, chairman - Willard Prince, Jason Clark, Alfred Phelps, John H. Sweet, Jonathan Harrington, Samuel W. Heath, and Martin Burlingame.


