Survey of plot of five acres of land sold  
 by J. Canning Treasurer of Lake County Ohio, unto  
 Ervin Wilson <sup>Dec. 26, 1842</sup> for the sum of 90 cents 1 mill the amount  
 of taxes interest and penalties due for the years 1841 & 1842  
 on  $11\frac{5}{16}$  acres of land, valued at 28 dollars, and entered  
 for taxation in the name of L. P. Carpenter, in the N. W.  
 part of Lot No. 18, in Tract No. in Township No. 10  
 in the 7 Range of Townships, as follows: commence  
 at a stake standing in the N. line of Lot No. 18 from  
 which a hemlock stump 2 feet in diameter bears N. 10° E.  
 39 Links distant, and a stake standing in the N. line  
 of the Girardeau road so called, being also in the N.  
 line of said Lot No. 18 - bears S. 1/4 N. 17° 6 chains distant.  
 Thence run N. 1/4° E. 3 chains 52 Links to the centre of the  
 channel of big creek so called, Thence up the channel  
 of said creek N. 74 1/2° E. 6 chains 36 Links - Thence along  
 the channel of said creek S. 77 1/2° E. 3 chains 95 Links - Thence  
 S. 29 1/4° E. along the bed of said creek 4 chains 58 Links  
 Thence S. 69 1/2° W. up the centre of 2d creek 1 chain 10 Links  
 Thence leaving the creek S. 89 3/4° W. 11 chains 20 Links  
 to the place of beginning.
