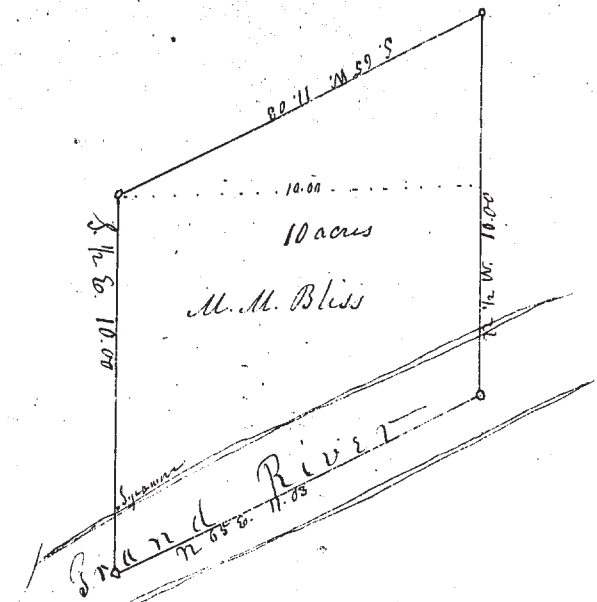

Survey of 10 acres of land sold on the 14th day of January 1850, by Silas A. Tisdell Treasurer of Lake County unto Orrin Willson for the sum of 84 cents & mills the amount of taxes, interest and penalty due for the years 1848 & 1849 on said 10 acres of land valued at 24 dol. less and entire for taxation in the name of Daniel Gow, being the Northwest part of the Hollister Mill Lot in Tract No 7 in Township No. 11 in the 6th Range of Townships (Madison) Beginning at the Northwest corner of said Hollister Mill Lot being on the top of the high bank of Grand River - thence by the West line of said Lot S 1/2 E. 10 Chs. to a point a little south of the center of Grand River which point is 16 7/8ths from a Sycamore tree 2 ft in diameter standing 5 feet East of the line on the North side of said River - thence up said River N. 65 E. 11 Chs. 3 fms. - thence N. 1/2 W. 10 Chs. to the top of the high bank - thence S 65 W. 11 Chs. 3 fms. to the place of beginning, containing Ten acres - Surveyed at the request of M. M. Bliss Assignee of said Orrin Willson Oct. 7th 1852

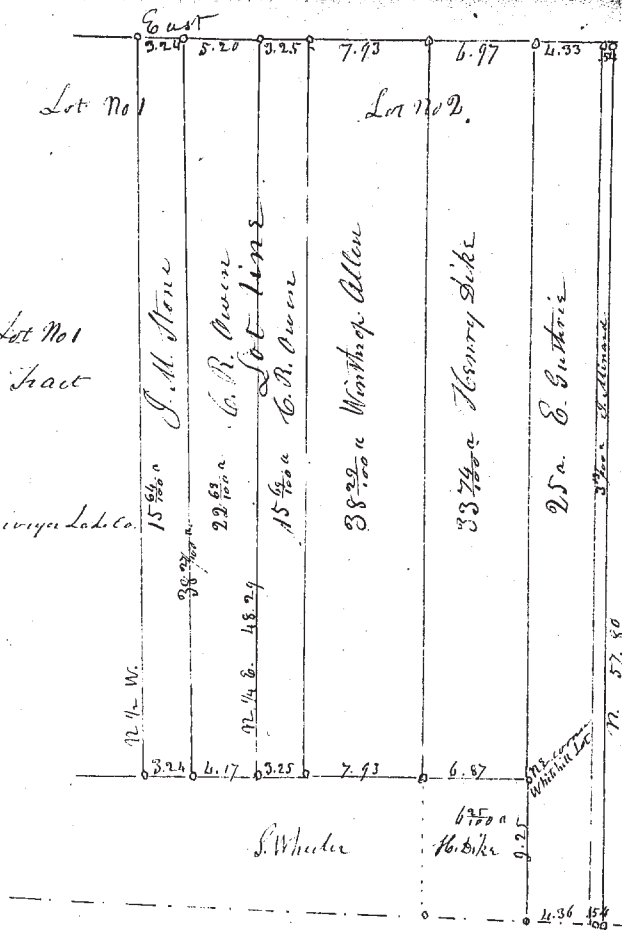

Survey of part of Lot No. 7 in Tract No 1 in Concord Beginning in the center of the State road from Painesville to Warren in the South line of Lyman Mitchell's land - thence by said Mitchell's south line, East 29.20 to a post - thence S. 7 3/4 W. 20.75 to the center of the road aforesaid - thence by said road N. 52 W. 33.49 to the place of beginning containing 30 acres
