

In conformity to an Act for ascertaining the boundaries of Counties, passed April 9<sup>th</sup> 1852. The undersigned in company of the Surveyor of Geauga County, by order of the Commissioners of their respective Counties, did on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of September A.D. 1855 run a part of the line between the Counties of Geauga and Lake as follows, to wit: Beginning at a post at the Northwest corner of Hamden in the County of Geauga, which post is also the Southwest corner of Leroy in the County of Lake, - thence run N. 89 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. on the line betwixt said townships to the center Road of Hamden township. - They marked said line by setting a stake in the centre of the State road from Fairmead to Warren at the point where said line crosses said road from which Stake an Elm tree 15 inches in diameter bears N. 23 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. distant 5 links and a Maple 5 inches in diameter bears S. 14 E. distant 7 1/2 links and a Cherry 4 inches in diameter bears S. 27 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. distant 4 links. They also set a stake in centre of, and at the termination of the center road in Hamden from which the Northwest corner of the School House bears S. 55 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. distant 9 1/2 links. They also found a stake set on said line at the termination of the Center Road in Leroy from which a Chestnut 10 inches in diameter bears N. 36 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. distant 9 1/2 links. They also further marked said line by setting stakes at several points on the same from which they took no bearings. The above survey signed by myself and the Surveyor of Geauga County was returned to the Clerk of Court of C.P. of said counties according to the requirements of the Statute.
