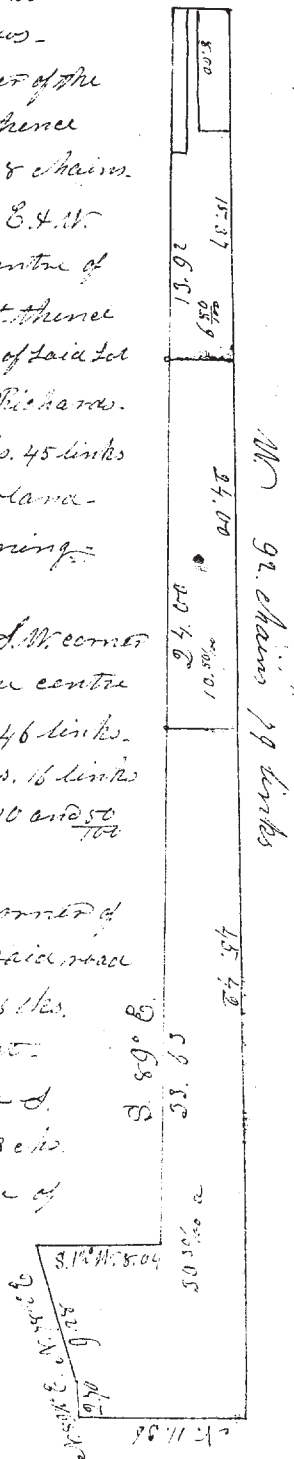

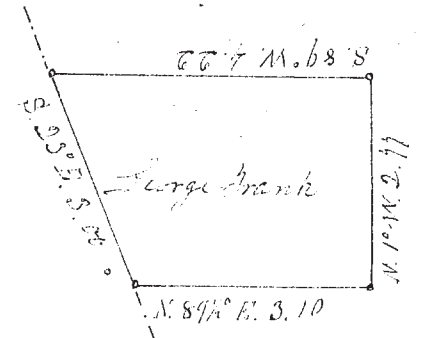


No. 42 Survey of a part of Lot No. 30 in Township No. 1 Township No. 9 Range No. 9 - as follows -
