Thence E. $88\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ N. 35 links to a stake from which a hemlock-stump three feet in diameter bears S. 22° E. 35 links distant. Thence N. $88\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W. 3 chs. 35 lks. to a post near the S.E. corner of Nelson Lewis sawmill, and substantiated ^{one of} as the original corner of S. D. Lewis' mill lot. by the testimony of Robert Brown, Solomon Brown & James H. Brown - Thence S. 34° W. 2 chs. 62 links. Thence S. 88° W. 3 chs. 56 links to a beech-stump on the bank of big creek, Thence S. 65° W. 1 ch. 68 links to a beech tree 8 inches in diameter. Thence S. 79° W. 4 chs. 80 links to a post from which an elm tree 10 inches diameter bears N. 34° E. 53 links distant. Thence S. $24\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W. 3 chs. to the E. line of Daniel Brown's lot. Thence N. $89\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ E. 20 chs. 90 links to a stake in the E. line of S. D. Lot No. 16 - Thence N. 45° W. along the state road 1 ch. Thence N. 53° W. to an angle in the road.
