Survey of the boundary line between the lands or Lots of Joseph Sawyer and the adjoining lands of Samuel Martindale & Daniel Sawyer in the Township of Mentor (Range 9 Town 10) - Vis beginning at a stake in the South line of Joseph Sawyer land and at the N. E. corner of Jonathan Root's land, as ascertained by the testimony of said Root and also by measurement from a stake standing at the S. W. corner of a piece of land of 12.12 acres now owned by said Sawyer known as the Liley Lot - Thence running N. 88 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° E. 16 chains 15 links to the west side of the road as at first laid out & travelled from the ridge road near said J. Sawyer's house to Hirstland at which point I cause a stake to be placed - Continuing - same course vis N. 88 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° E. 15 chains 20 links to a stake at the S. E. corner of Daniel Sawyer's lot. Thence N. 26 $\frac{2}{3}$ ° W. on the W. line of Daniel Sawyer's lot 44 chains to the N. line of the tract known as the Basfield tree -

Also surveyed the bounds of the 12 acre piece above mentioned - beginning at the stake in the S. W. corner of said piece thence running N. 88 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° E. 12 chains 75 links to a stake in the west line of the road leading from the ridge road to Hirstland - from which ~~enters~~ elm tree three feet in diameter bears S. 74 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° N. 63 links distant - thence N. 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° N. following the line of the old road 10 chains 15 links to a stake -
