


 four chains to a post thence west one chain to a
 post thence South four chains to a post standing in the
 North line of Joseph Street; thence East along the North
 line of Joseph Street one chain to the place of begin-
 ning containing forty hundredths of an acre of land.

 to the centre of Smith Street; thence South along said Street
 two chains; thence West five chains to the place of beginning
 containing one acre of land.
