

Survey & Establishment of line between the lands of James Nolan & S. Quirk in the south part of Lot No. 10 in Tract No. 4 in Madison Township according to the evidence of Willard Foster, James Nolan & Thomas Nolan.

Beginning at a piece of stone pump set in the ground in the East line of Mc Mackin's land and the corner of said James Nolan & S. Quirk's land. Said piece of Stone Pump is 4 chains & 2 links north of the South line of said Lot No. 10. Thence S. 86° E. 12 chains & 76 links to the center of the road. Set a piece of Stone pump on the line 37 links westward from the center of the road, from which a Hard Maple tree about 6 inches in diameter bears N. 37° E. 7 links distant, and the N. E. corner of S. Quirk's dwelling house bears S. 46 1/4° W.

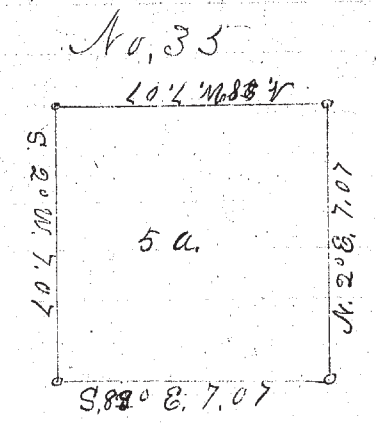
