 by G. S. Munson County Surveyor.

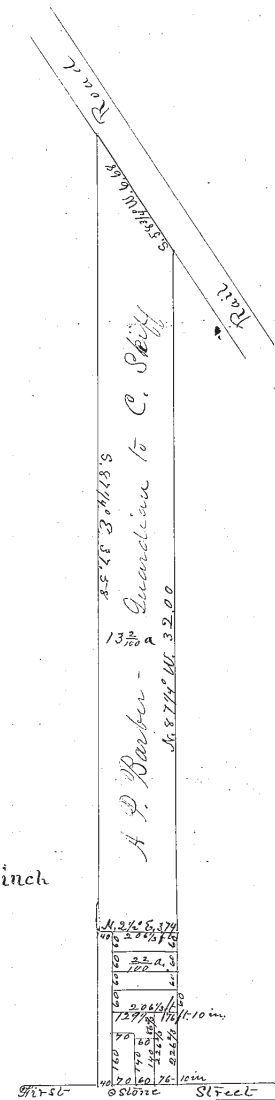
DESCRIPTION.

Survey of part of Lot No. 107 Willoughby Village, laying out a Street 40 feet wide and 466 2/3 feet long, along the South line of said lot from the West line of First Street. Also laying off four lots on north side of said new street 60 feet wide + 206 2/3 feet long, and then surveyed the remainder of said lot to the Rail Road as follows. Beginning in the South line of said lot at the West end of the new street, thence N. 2 1/2° E. 3 Chains + 74 Links to the North line of said lot, thence with said line N. 87 1/4° W. 32 Chains to the R. R. land, thence with said land S. 58 3/4° W. 60 Chains + 68 Links to the South line of said lot, thence with said line S. 87 1/4° E. 37 Chains + 58 Links to the place of beginning. Containing 13 1/2 a.
