Plat of Liberty Street, No. 25, Painesville Town 11, Range 8

Survey made Sept. 27th 1887, at the request of County Commissioners
 For the purpose of Re-establishing the lines of Liberty Street, South of South Street
 by H. N. Meunson County Surveyor.

DESCRIPTION.

Beginning at a piece of Stone pump set at the angle of Liberty Street 10 feet
 westerly from the South line of South Street, from which same Stone set by David
 Ken in 1836 to establish the east line of Liberty Street + North line of South Street
 bears N. 46 1/4° E. 55 feet + 5 inches distant also Stone set at same time to
 establish the west line of Liberty Street + North line of South Street bears N. 63 3/4° W.
 55 feet distant thence S. 8 3/4° E. (at 24 chains + 47 links the center of Walnut
 Street, at 36 chains + 56 links the center of the N. E. C. + St. C. R. R., at 39
 chains and 46 links set a piece of Stone Pump in the South line of
 the Incorporated Village of Painesville, from which the South East Corner
 of the Water works building bears N. 56° W. 54 feet + 8 inches distant) 326 Rods
 to a piece of Stone pump set in ground from which a Hard Maple tree
 2 inches in diameter bears N. 79 1/2° E. 34 feet distant, and the Center of the Stone
 Pier on the North side of the Arch for roadway under the P.P. & F. R. R. bears
 S. 11° W. 6 chains + 36 links dist.
