Plat of Change in <sup>Brook</sup> Black Road, No. 6, Mentor Town 10, Range 9

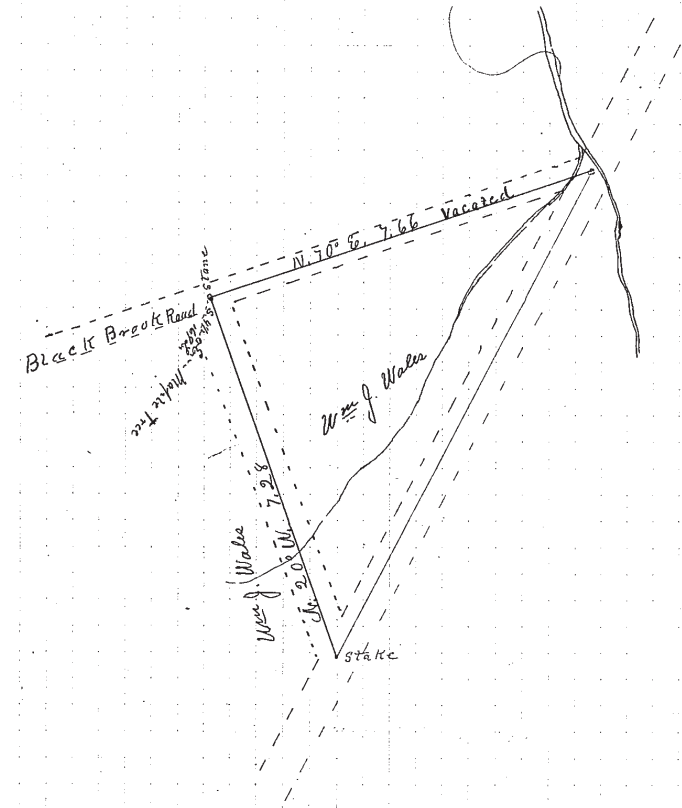
Survey made June 22<sup>nd</sup> 1886, at the request of James Lapham & others  
 For the purpose of laying new road across Wm. J. Wale's land from Black Brook road to Richmond road, & vacating that portion of Black Brook road lying between the new road & Richmond road by H. N. Munson County Surveyor.

**DESCRIPTION.**

Survey of road petitioned for by James Lapham & others  
 Beginning in the center of Richmond at a stake, in Lot No. 5 in Tract No. 10, thence N. 20° W. 7 chains + 28 links to a hard head stone set at or near the center of Black Brook road, from which from a hard maple tree about 16 inches in diameter bears S. 4 1/2° E. 69 links distant. Also surveyed line of portion of Black Brook road which is vacated, beginning at the above mentioned stone, thence N. 70° E. 7.66 to center of Richmond road.
