Plat of Survey - O. Hodges, No. 64, Painesville Town 11, Range 8

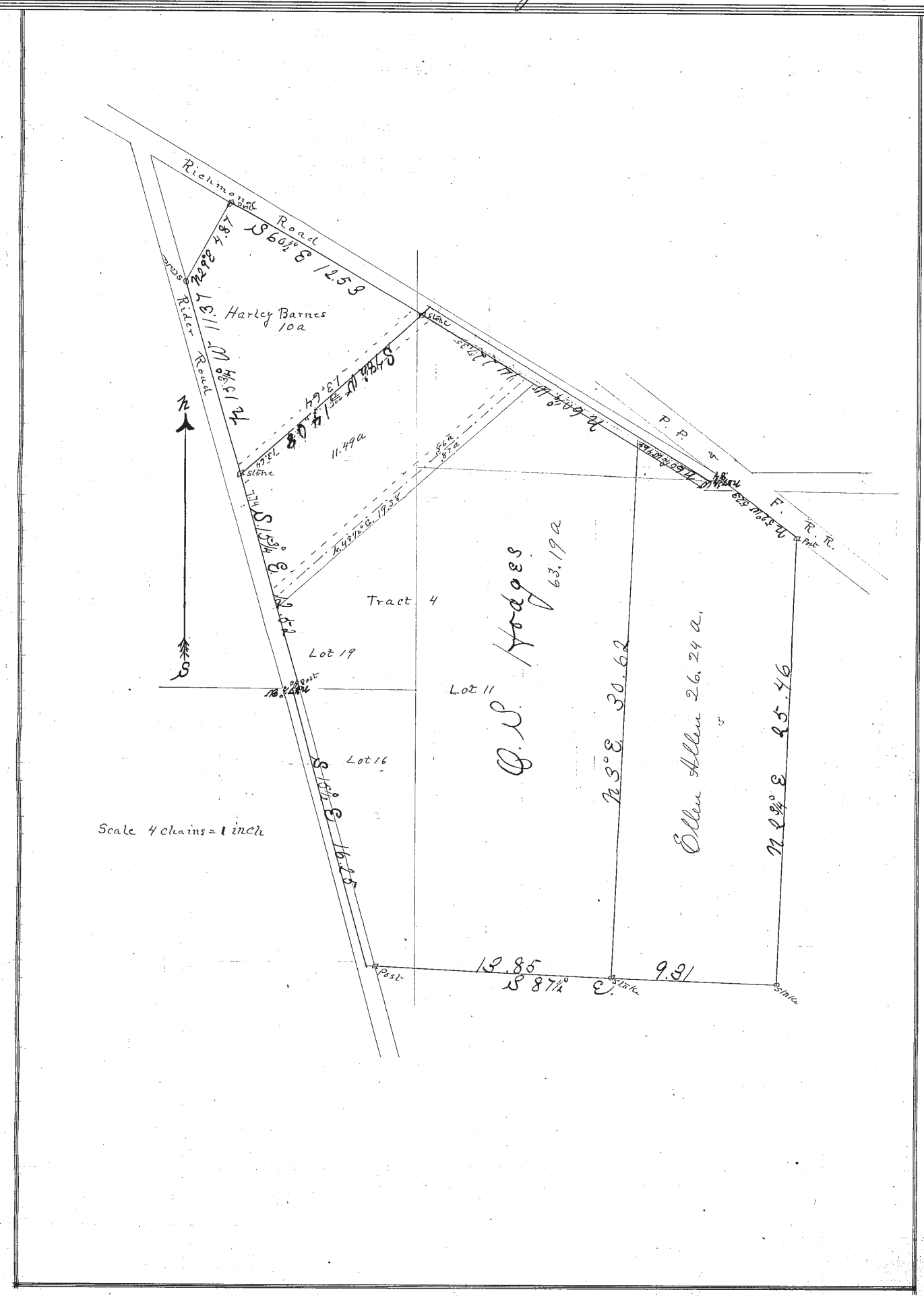
Survey made July 5th 1889, at the request of Harley Barnes Esq.,
For the purpose of conveying 10 acres to Harley Barnes & finding the lines and amount left W. Hodges
by County Surveyor.

DESCRIPTION.

Beginning at a stone in the Easterly line of Rider road, and at its Southwesterly corner of 10 acres conveyed to H. Barnes, thence S. 15 1/4° E. 12 chains + 52 links to a post, thence N. 87 1/2° W. 40 links to the center of Rider road, thence with same S. 15 1/2° E. 16 chains + 25 links, thence S. 87 1/2° E. 13 chains + 85 links to a stake at the South west corner of Ellen Allen's land, thence with west line of said land, N. 2 3/4° W. 30 chains + 60 links to the center of Richmond Road, thence with same N. 60 1/4° W. 14 chains and 22 links to South Easterly corner of said 10 acres sold Harley Barnes, thence with the southerly line of same S. 48 1/2° W. 14 chains + 8 links to the place of beginning. Containing 63 1/1000 acres
