DESCRIPTION.

Survey of ten acres of land, in Tract No. 12, Killboughby township, and bounded as follows: Beginning at a stone in the center of the Main Road at the Southwesterly corner of E. B. Young's land, and the Easterly line of Marshall's land, thence with said line S. 43³/₄° E. 26 chains and 13 links to a stone in the West line of J. W. Stocking's land, thence with said line N. 2° E, 5 chains and 82 links to a stone thence N. 43³/₄° W., 22 chains to the center of said road, thence with said road, S. 47° W., 4 chains and 16 links to the place of beginning, Containing 10 acres of land.
