Copy of Journal entry 10. annex territory from Concord 10, Jamesville township
 on petition of George Blish and others

At a special meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Lake County held at the Auditor's office in Xenia on Saturday April 21st 1874 - Present Charles B. Smith
 post proctor and Sam. H. Haskins and J. Bennett - The record of the regular meeting held March 6, 7, 8 & 9th 1874 was read and consideration of same
 Bennett it was noted that the usual proceedings of the Board of Commissioners upon the said petition of George Blish and
 others is incomplete and ought not to be approved. - On Motion of Sam. Haskins it was by unanimous vote ordered that same be read complete record of
 the said proceedings and decision ought to be made and that the following report be ordered to be entered upon the journal as a full and complete record
 of the proceedings in that behalf done - At regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Lake County at the office of the County Auditor
 on the 9th day of March 1874 the petition of George Blish and others for withdrawal of the township of Concord asking to be detached from the said
 township of Concord and attached to and made part of the township of Xenia in Lake County same as to be heard before the said Board of Com-
 missioners and therefore it being shown on the part of said petitioners that same were first duly given in accordance
 with the statute in such case made and provided by act of the Legislature at this point before the Board of the territory proposed to be attached
 and changed as provided of this application and it being further shown that same were first duly given in accordance with the statute in such case
 proposed to be changed was given to the said petitioners asking for such change and it being further shown that the facts and allegations in the
 said petition are true and that it is inconvenient for the people residing within the bounds of the said territory to go to the polls in said township
 of Concord and that their interest and convenience will be greatly subserved by being changed and made a part of the township of Xenia in
 the said Board of Commissioners do therefore find that due notice has been given of this application and that same were first duly given in accordance
 of the provisions requiring in the territory proposed to be changed from said the said petitioners asking for such change and it is expedient and
 and necessary to detach from the township of Concord and attach to and make part of the township of Xenia in the territory within the bounds
 described in the said petition -

It is therefore ordered by the said Board of Commissioners that the said territory from and of the said do be and the
 same is hereby detached and separated from the said township of Concord and attached to and made part of the township of Xenia in
 the said - And it is further ordered that the said petitioners forthwith cause to be made and published in the County Auditor's and approved maps
 or plan of the said territory as described in the said petition and that the same be recorded in the books provided for that purpose together with
 this entry and the said petition of said George Blish and others -

In the Commission of Lake County Ohio - The Petition of the undivided householders of the Township of Concord, respectfully, set forth that whereas a portion of said Township hereafter described for various reasons memorably and disadvantageously located particularly with reference to its distance from the New House, and its relation to the business - and whereas the location for school purposes in said township is very unequal divided by reason of that portion of the township not desired to be set off being much more sparsely settled and having therefore smaller land more numerous school districts than that portion asking to be detached hereby extending on the latter much more than the former - Whereas the school district in which the householders of this district are compelled to send their children is owned in part by the undersigned householders of the township of Concord and the cost and maintenance of the same - in consequence of which the maintenance of said school is greatly impeded and its benefits greatly diminished all of which may be remedied by granting your petition for and finally Whereas for similar reasons a large portion of an adjoining township has been annexed to this township and it being in your petition annexed to this township so that the granting of this petition will not diminish the original size of the township - Therefore your petitioners do respectfully pray that your honorable body will in consideration of the premises herein set forth detach from said township of Concord and annex to the township of Summerville the following described tract of land in accordance with statute in such cases made and provided - To wit: Commencing at a point described as the south westerly corner of lot 31 in tract 4 and proceeding thence easterly along the southwesterly corner of lot 37 and 38 to the southwesterly corner of lot 39. Thence along the southwesterly and easterly boundaries of the land owned by George Blish in said lot 39 to where said easterly boundary intersects the easterly line of said lot 39. Thence northwesterly along said easterly line to its junction with the southwesterly line of lot 53. Thence easterly along said southwesterly line to the easterly line of said lot. Thence northwesterly along said easterly line to its junction with the southwesterly boundary of the township line to the southwesterly line of said township. Thence along said westerly line southwesterly to the place of beginning. All of the lands included within said boundaries lying and being in tract 4 Concord Township Lake County Ohio - and comprising all of lots numbers 37, 38, 43, 44, 45 and 46 and so much of lot number 49, 50, 51, 52, and 53 as are within said township and so much of lot 39 as herebefore set forth and which is known and designated as Road District No 1 Concord Township - and so your petitioners will ever pray &c.
