

RECORD OF SURVEYS,

Plat of *Survey*, No. *48*, *Perry* Town *11*, Range *7*

Survey made *May 11th* 1896, at the request of *the County Commissioners*
 For the purpose of *opening a road along the Bank of Lake Erie from the Maunson road so called*
to intersect the next road east and at what is known as Pannly Point in Perry Tp
 by *Frank M Barber* County Surveyor.

Surveyors report to the County Commissioners **DESCRIPTION.**

To The Honorable Board of County Commissioners =
In obedience to the foregoing order. I proceeded on the days referred to and mentioned in the
foregoing report of views to survey and mark a county road in Perry Tp.
Beginning at a point in the center of the Maunson (or Leo Pannly) road and northly from a Black Walnut
tree which marks the center of said road a distance of 36 1/2 feet. Thence N 62 1/2° E (8.00) eight chains
to a stake. Thence N 59° E (3.73) three chains & seventy three links to a stake. Thence N 71° E (2.57) two
chains and fifty seven links to a stake. Thence N 62 1/2° E (4.43) four chains and forty three links
to the center of a county road. Thence along the center of said road S 57° E (6.30) six chains and fifty
links to a point in said road from which a Maple tree bears N 40 1/2° E and distant (40) forty feet
Thence N 21 1/2° W (7.41) seven chains & forty one links to the water's edge of Lake Erie =
