To the Board of Commissioners of Lake Co. O.  
 The undersigned in obedience to your order, dated December 9<sup>th</sup> 1897. I proceeded on the day specified to survey & mark the county road described in said order under the direction of the viewers therein named, & respectfully submit the following return of said survey  
 Beginning at the intersection of The Cleveland Road and Maple street so called, at an iron rod driven in the center of said roads. Thence S 2 1/2° W (1135) Eleven hundred and thirty five feet to an iron rod driven in the center of said maple street, said Point being (180) one hundred and eighty feet north of the north line of lot 6, tract 13. Thence N 86 1/4° W & parallel with said lot line (1306) Thirteen hundred and six feet to the east line of the Fowler road so called for more minute details see annexed plat
