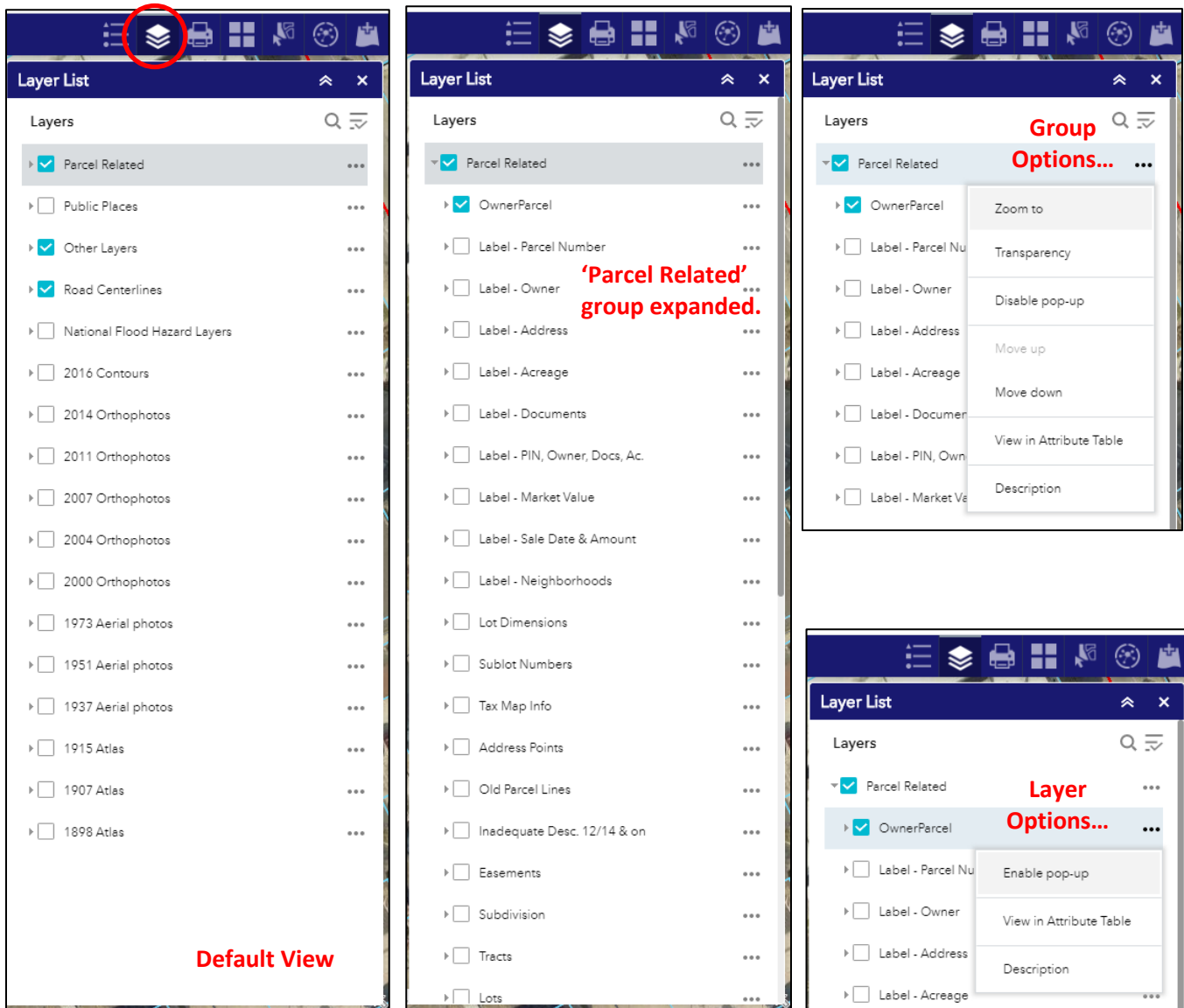




**Description:** This tool located in the upper right header toolbar opens a window listing all the layers that are available and the ability to modify their visibility and some characteristics.

**Function:** By default the ‘Layer List’ window is open when the application loads. Data layers and groupings are listed with checkboxes that control the data’s visibility in the map. The three main groupings are ‘Parcel Related’, ‘Public Places’, and ‘Other Layers’. To see what is in each grouping, click the small arrow next to the name to expand the listing. Groups and stand-alone layers have additional options available by clicking on the ellipsis icon (3 dots). These options include the ability to control a layer’s transparency, move the layer up and down in the listing, and zoom to features. Clicking on the ellipsis for a layer within a group will give you options like opening the attribute table and enabling popup information.



Clicking the arrow next to a layer will show you the symbology / legend of a layer like the different road classifications or soil types.
