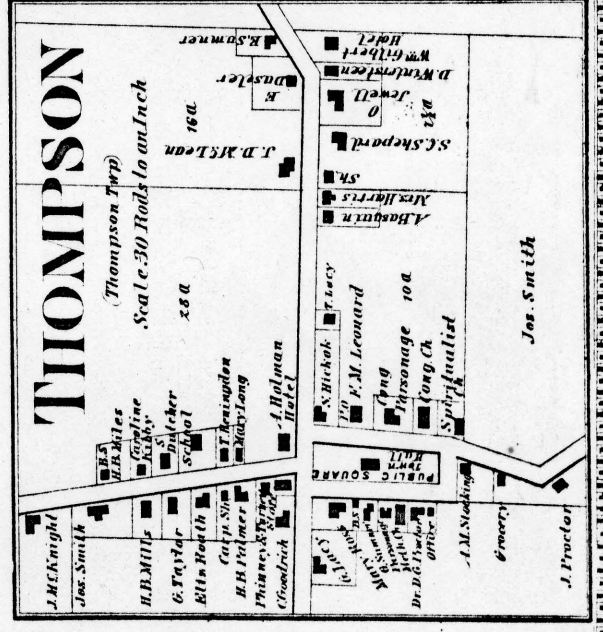
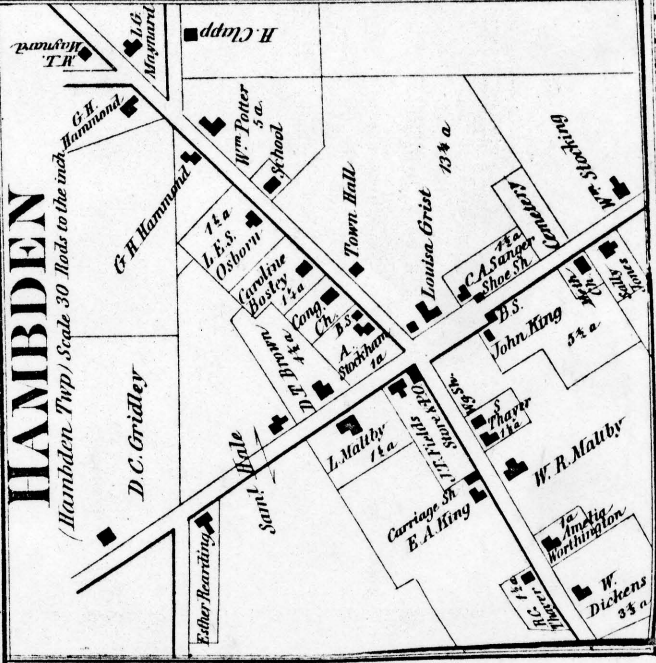
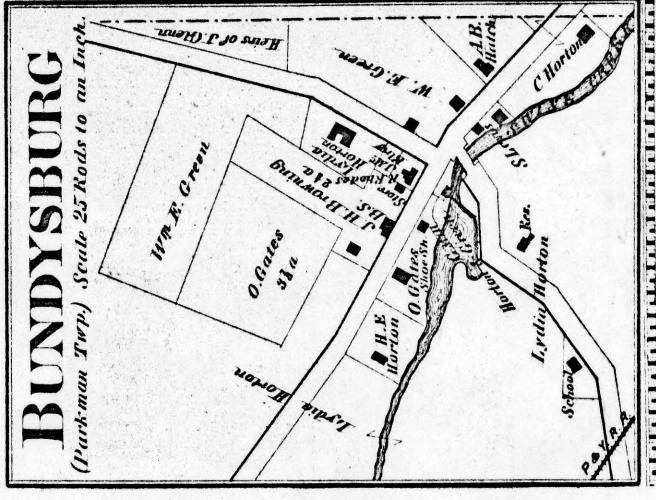
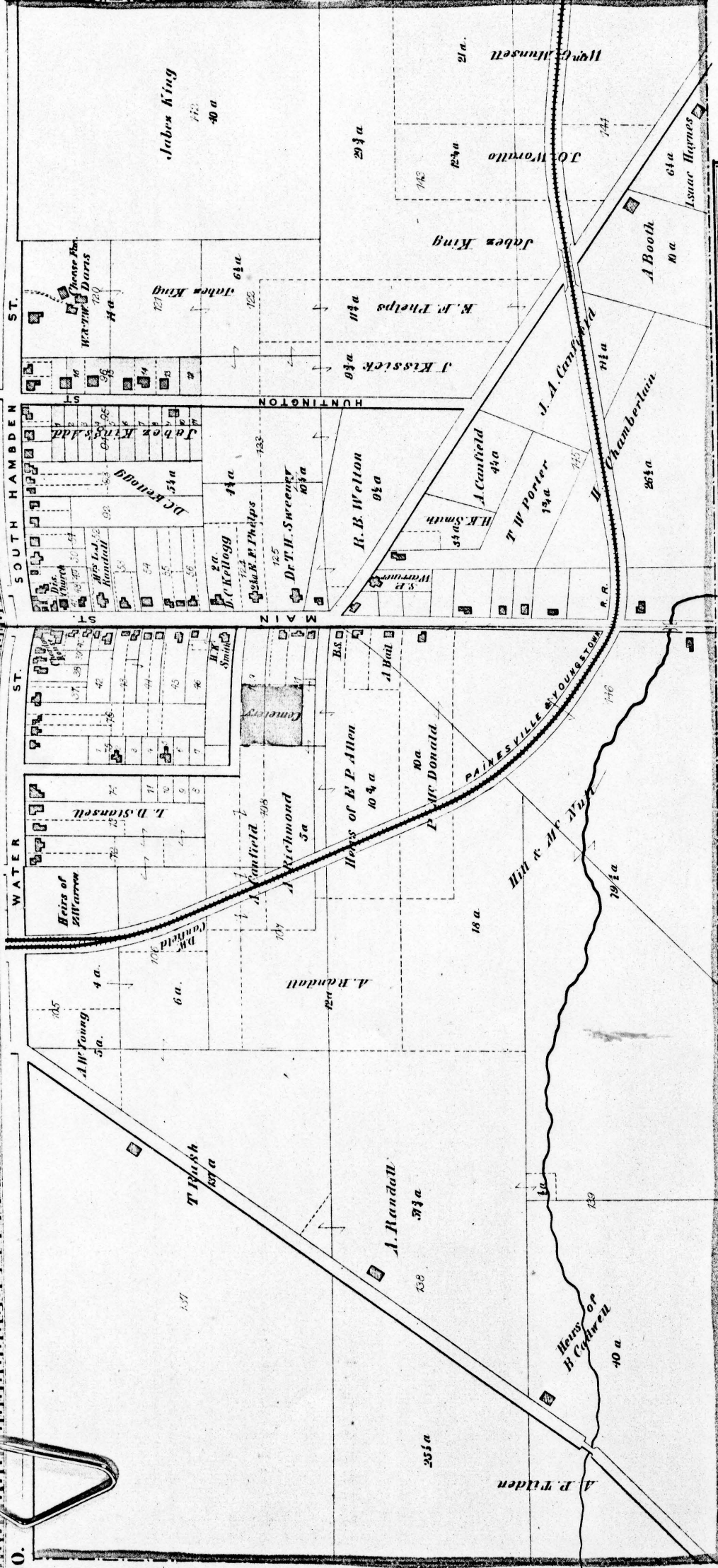


# SOUTH PART of CLARDON
