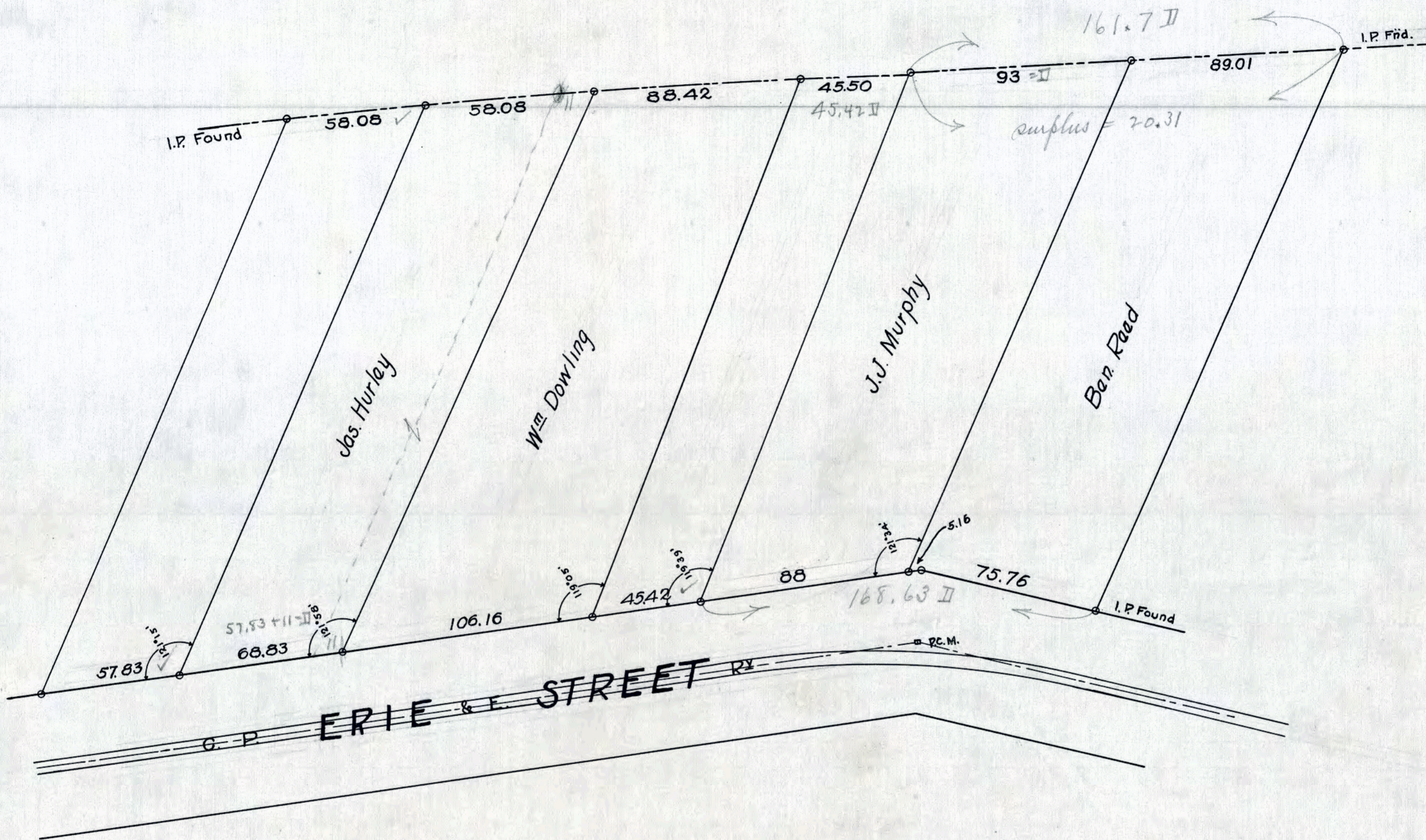


SURVEY OF
