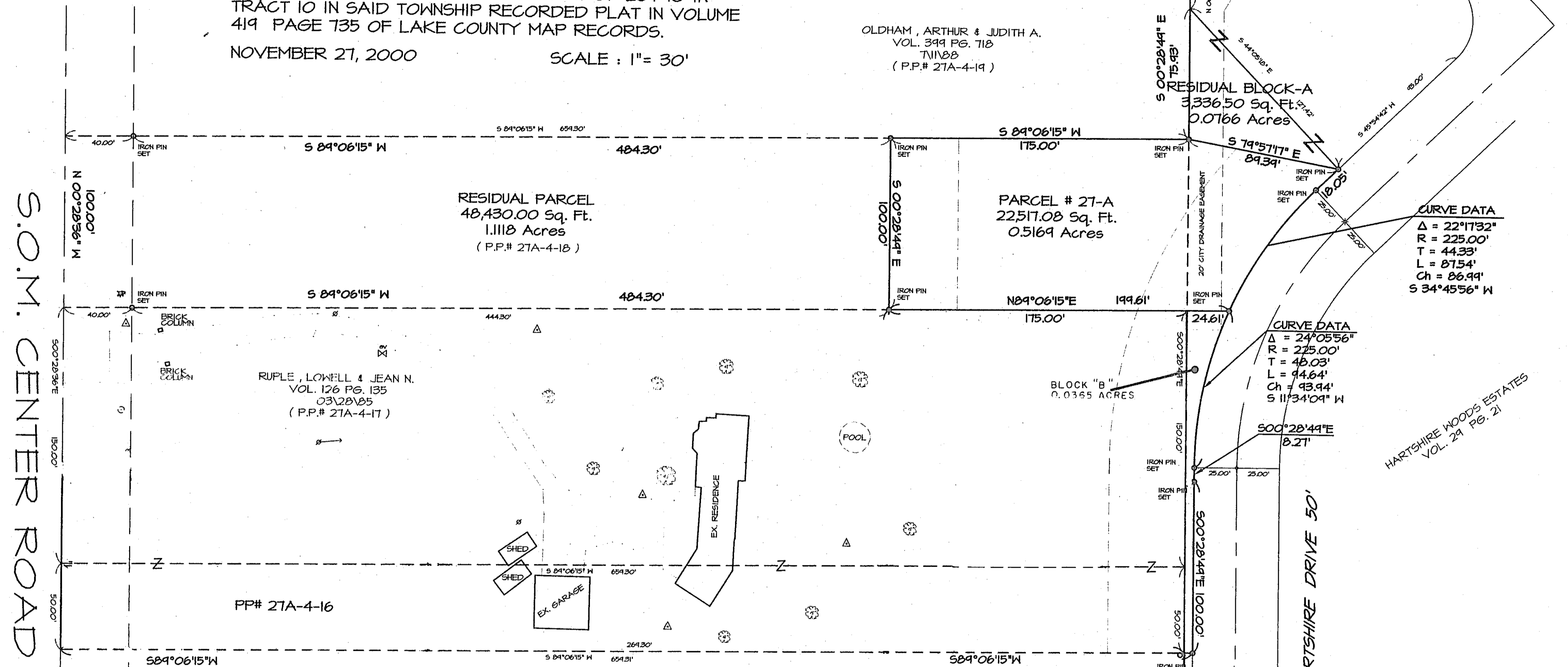


LOT SPLIT for THOMAS J. ACKERMAN

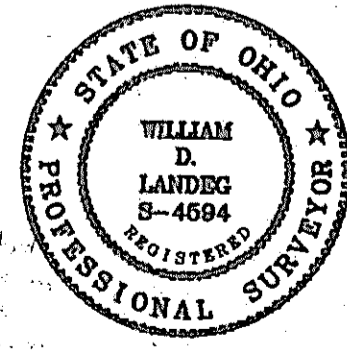
