THIS PROJECT SHALL CONSIST OF THE SAFETY UPGRADING AND RESURFACING OF SR 44 FROM THE COUNTY LINE TO 0.29 MILES NORTH OF SR 84. ITEMS INCLUDED SHALL BE WEARING COURSE REMOVED, FULL DEPTH PAVEMENT REPAIR, ASPHALT CONCRETE OVERLAY, GUARDRAIL, DRAINAGE AND SIGNING.

#### RIGHT OF WAY

ALL WORK SHALL BE PERFORMED WITHIN THE EXISTING RIGHT OF WAY OR EASEMENTS.

THE APPENDIX OF ASTME 380 SHALL BE UTILIZED FOR ANY ADDITIONAL CONVERSION FACTORS REQUIRED. CONVERSIONS SHALL BE APPROPRIATELY PRECISE AND SHALL REFLECT STANDARD INDUSTRY ENGLISH VALUES WHERE SUITABLE.

- 2) THE STORAGE OF EQUIPMENT, MATERIALS, AND VEHICLES WITHIN THE HIGHWAY RIGHT OF WAY WILL BE PERMITTED. THE NUMBER OF AREAS AND EXACT LOCATIONS SHALL BE APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER.
- 3) ALL DISTURBED AREAS SHALL BE RETURNED TO THEIR ORIGINAL CONDITION AT NO EXPENSE TO THE STATE.
