GENERAL NOTES

SPECIFICATIONS

ALL ITEMS APPEARING THROUGHOUT THESE PLANS REFERRING TO THE 1963 CONSTRUCTION AND MATERIAL SPECIFICATIONS ARE TO BE USED FOR REFERENCE PURPOSES ONLY. THIS PROJECT SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE 1967 CONSTRUCTION AND MATERIAL SPECIFICATIONS. THE CROSS REFERENCE TO THE 1967 SPECIFICATIONS IS INCLUDED IN THESE GENERAL NOTES AND SHOWN ON THE GENERAL SUMMARY SHEET NOS. 7-A AND 8-A.

FIELD OFFICE

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL, IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF 105,152, PROVIDE A SUITABLE FIELD OFFICE HAVING A MINIMUM OF 300 SO. FT. OF FLOOR SPACE. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL HAVE A TELEPHONE INSTALLED AND MAINTAINED IN THIS FIELD OFFICE DURING THE CONSTRUCTION OF THIS PROJECT. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ALSO PROVIDE AND MAINTAIN SANITARY PROVISIONS AS PER 107.06. ALL THE ABOVE IS INCLUDED IN THE LUMP SUM PRICE BID FOR FIELD OFFICE.

TRAFFIC MAINTENANCE

S.R. 91 SHALL BE CLOSED TO THROUGH TRAFFIC, AND DETOURS WILL BE PROVIDED AS INDICATED ON THE TITLE SHEET.

TWO-WAY TRAFFIC SHALL BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES ON U.S.R. 20 BY USE OF EITHER THE EXISTING PAVEMENT, THE PROPOSED PAVEMENT OR TEMPORARY ROADWAYS SURFACED WITH 410 AGGREGATE AND STABLIZED WITH ITEM 616 CALCIUM CHLORIDE.

ESTIMATED QUANTITIES OF 404, 410 AND 616 HAVE BEEN PROVIDED IN THE GENERAL SUMMARY FOR MAINTAINING TRAFFIC, AND SHALL BE APPLIED AT LOCATIONS WHERE DIRECTED AND IN THE AMOUNTS SPECIFIED BY THE ENGINEER.

ITEM 404 - ASPHALT CONCRETE SURFACE COURSE OR AN APPROVED BITUMINOUS PRE-MIXED ITEM 410 - TRAFFIC COMPACTED SURFACE, TYPE "A" OR "B" 450 CU.YDS.

MAINTENANCE OF LOCAL ACCESS

LOCAL ACCESS SHALL BE MAINTAINED AT ALL TIMES ON S.R. 91 and U.S.R. 20, BY USE OF EITHER THE EXISTING PAVEMENT, THE PROPOSED PAVEMENT OR TEMPORARY ROADWAYS. THE ESTIMATED QUANTITIES PROVIDED IN THE TRAFFIC MAINTENANCE NOTE INCLUDE QUANTITIES OF 404, 410 AND 616 FOR MAINTAINING LOCAL ACCESS.

UNDERGROUND UTILITIES

THE LOCATIONS OF THE UNDERGROUND UTILITIES SHOWN ON THE PLANS HAVE BEEN OBTAINED BY DILIGENT FIELD CHECKS AND SEARCHES OF AVAILABLE RECORDS. IT IS BELIEVED THAT THEY ARE ESSENTIALLY CORRECT, BUT THE STATE OF OHIO DOES NOT GUARANTEE THEIR ACCURACY OR COMPLETE-

ANY OR ALLXWORK REQUIRED YEOR PUBLIC OR TRRIVATE UTILITY SES WILL BE DONE BY AND AT THE EXPENSE OF THE TR RESPECTIVE OWNERS, UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED ON THESE PLANS.

FEDERAL AID CONSTRUCTION IDENTIFICATION SIGNS

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL FURNISH, ERECT, MAINTAIN AND SUBSEQUENTLY REMOVE FEDERAL AID CONSTRUCTION IDENTIFICATION SIGNS AT EACH OF THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS:

1. RIGHT SIDE OF U.S. 20 (EUCLID AVE.) AT STA. 2 + 00 2. LEFT SIDE OF U.S. 20 (EUCLID AVE.) AT STA. 15 + 00

SIGN DETAILS SHALL BE AS SPECIFIED ON STANDARD DRAWING FACI-1, "CODE N-54(1)-

THE SIGNS SHALL BE ERECTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH STANDARD DRAWING FACI-2. ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH NOTES IN THE PROPOSAL.

REMOVAL OF EXISTING PIPE

THE REMOVAL OF ALL EXISTING PIPE DRAINS WHICH WOULD NORMALLY BE REMOVED IN VARIOUS EXCAVATION ITEMS SHALL BE INCLUDED FOR PAYMENT IN THE UNIT PRICES BID FOR THE RESPECTIVE EXCAVATION ITEMS, UNLESS OTHERWISE ITEMIZED IN THE PLANS.

REMOVAL OF TREES AND STUMPS

ALL TREES AND STUMPS SPECIFICALLY MARKED FOR REMOVAL WITHIN THE CONSTRUCTION LIMITS OF THIS PROJECT SHALL BE REMOVED UNDER THE LUMP SUM PRICE BID FOR ITEM 201 CLEARING AND GRUBBING, EXCEPT THAT THOSE TREES FOR WHICH PROTECTION AND PRESERVATION WORK IS INDICATED ELSEWHERE IN THESE PLANS SHALL NOT BE REMOVED.

THE FOLLOWING IS AN APPROXIMATE ESTIMATE OF THE NUMBER OF TREES AND STUMPS TO BE

THE ABOVE ESTIMATE IS APPROXIMATE AND THE STATE OF OHIO RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ORDER THE REMOVAL OF ADDITIONAL TREES OR STUMPS OUTSIDE OF THE LIMITS OF CONSTRUCTION BUT WITHIN THE RIGHT-of-WAY AND/OR EASEMENT LINES. PAYMENT FOR THE REMOVAL OF THESE ADDITIONAL TREES OR STUMPS SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE LUMP SUM PRICE BID FOR ITEM 201 CLEARING AND GRUBBING.

REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF EXISTING NON-RIGID PAVEMENT UNLESS OTHERWISE INDICATED ON THESE PLANS, SHALL BE MEASURED AND PAID FOR AS ITEM E-1, ROADWAY EXCAVATION.

REMOVAL OF EXISTING RIGID PAVEMENT

EXISTING RIGID TYPE PAVEMENTS SHALL BE REMOVED UNDER ITEM 202 WHEN THEY ARE LOCATED LESS THAN 3 FEET BELOW THE PROPOSED PAVEMENT SUBGRADE IN PROPOSED PAVEMENT AREAS OR LESS THAN 3 FEET BELOW THE PROPOSED FINISHED SURFACE IN AREAS OUTSIDE THE PROPOSED PAVEMENT.

WHEN EXISTING RIGID TYPE PAVEMENTS LIE BELOW THE ABOVE LIMITS, THEY SHALL NOT BE REMOVED. IN LIEU THEREOF, THEY SHALL BE BROKEN UP IN PLACE INTO PORTIONS NOT TO EXCEED ONE SQUARE FOOT IN AREA PRIOR TO PLACEMENT OF PROPOSED EMBANKMENT. PAYMENT FOR THIS OPERATION SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE UNIT PRICE BID FOR ITEM 203 EXCAVATION.

ITEM 203 PROOF ROLLING

AN ESTIMATED QUANTITY FOR THIS ITEM HAS BEEN PROVIDED IN THE GENERAL SUMMARY FOR USE IN PROOF ROLLING OF SUBGRADE FOR THE MAINLINE AND RAMP PAVEMENT室, AND FOR PAVED SHOULDERS: IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUPPLEMENTAL SPECIFICATION 801.

SEEDING

OUANTITIES FOR SEEDING ARE CALCULATED FOR THE SOIL AREAS BETWEEN THE RIGHT-OF-WAY LINES AND WITHIN THE WORK LIMITS FOR AREAS OUTSIDE THE RIGHT-OF-WAY LINES COVERED BY WORK AGREEMENT OR SLOPE EASEMENT.

AGRICULTURAL LIMING MATERIAL

THE LOCATION AND NEED FOR AGRICULTURAL LIMING MATERIALS WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE ENGINEER ON THE BASIS OF LABORATORY TESTS AFTER ROUGH GRADING OPERATIONS HAVE BEEN PER-FORMED. THE QUANTITY OF AGRICULTURAL LIMING MATERIAL SHOWN ON THE PLANS IS SUFFICIENT FOR APPLICATION TO THE ENTIRE EXPOSED SOIL AREA OF THE CONTRACT BUT MAY BE PARTIALLY OR COM-PLETELY OMITTED, AS MAY BE DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER IF LABORATORY TESTS INDICATE THE ITEM IS NOT NEEDED. AGRICULTURAL LIMING MATERIAL SHALL BE APPLIED AT THE RATE OF 100 POUNDS PER 1,000 SQUARE FEET OF SURFACE AREA, EXCEPT THAT ON ALL SURFACES OF SHALE IT SHALL BE APPLIED AT THE RATE OF 10 TONS PER ACRE.

THE QUANTITY OF AGRICULTURAL LIMING MATERIAL IS ESTIMATED AND IS INCLUDED FOR USE ONLY WHEN AND IN AMOUNTS AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER. THE AMOUNT OF THIS ITEM AND ITS LOCATION SHALL BE RECORDED AS USED, AND PAYMENT WILL BE INCLUDED IN THE FINAL PAYMENT ESTIMATE.

ALTHOUGH THIS ITEM HAS BEEN ESTIMATED FOR USE ON THE ENTIRE EXISTING/BITUMINOUS PAVEMENT AREA TO BE RESURFACED, IT SHALL BE USED ONLY ON TRY OR CHECKED PAVEMENT AREAS WHERE SPECIFICALLY DIRECTED & THE ENGINEER

PAY QUANTITIES FOR THAS ITEM SHALL BE DETERMINED BY FINAL MEASUREMENT

ITEM 616 DUST CONTROL

THE FOLLOWING ESTIMATED OUANTITIES HAVE BEEN PROVIDED FOR APPLICATION FOR THE PRE-VENTION OR ALLEVIATION OF DUST WHERE DIRECTED, AND IN THE AMOUNTS SPECIFIED BY THE ENGINEER.

MAINTENANCE OF SEWER FLOWS

THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONDUCT HIS OPERATIONS SO AS TO MAINTAIN AT ALL TIMES SEWER FLOWS THROUGH EXISTING FACILITIES TO REMAIN IN PLACE AND THROUGH EXISTING FACILITIES TO BE REPLACED UNTIL NEW FACILITIES ARE COMPLETED AND PLACED INTO USE.

PAYMENT FOR ANY ADDITIONAL COSTS INVOLVED IN MAINTAINING THESE FLOWS BY PUMPING OR BY ANY OTHER MEANS APPROVED BY THE ENGINEER SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE UNIT PRICES BID FOR THE RESPECTIVE ITEMS OF 603 CONDUIT.

DRAINAGE OF BASE MATERIAL

WHERE THE BASE MATERIAL IS DRAINED BY 605 AGGREGATE DRAINS, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL FINISH, SEED, AND MULCH THE SLOPES SO AS NOT TO IMPEDE DRAINAGE OF THE BASE MATERIAL. THE ACTUAL AREA OF THE OUTCROP OF THE AGGREGATE DRAINS SHALL NOT BE SEEDED.

CONNECTIONS TO EXISTING PIPE

AT PLACES WHERE THE PLANS PROVIDE FOR PROPOSED PIPE TO BE CONNECTED TO EXISTING PIPE. IT SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR TO LOCATE THE EXISTING PIPE BOTH AS TO LINE AND GRADE BEFORE HE STARTS TO LAY THE PROPOSED PIPE. THE COST OF THIS OPERATION SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE UNIT PRICE BID FOR THE PERTINENT 603 CONDUIT ITEM.
