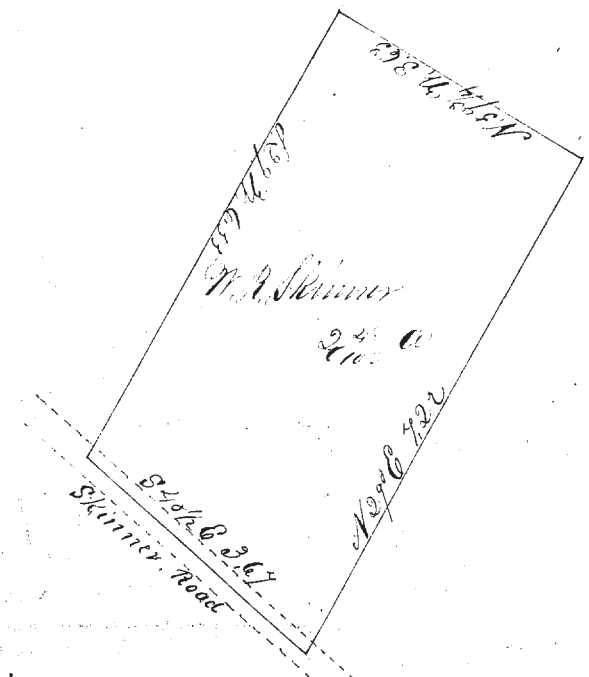


Survey of four pieces of land situated in Middle part of Lot No three (3) south of G. Lloyd's tract No 12 in Township No 9 in the 10th range of Townships as follows to wit two acres of land sold by Henry Woodworth Treasurer of Lake County to Benj. D. Cheaney the 11th day of January A.D. 1847 for the sum of one dollar & 47 cents the amount of taxes interest and penalty due for the years 1845 & 1846 entered for taxation in the name of George Black - Also 2 acres of land sold by W. Woodworth Treasurer of Lake County to B. D. Cheaney January 8th 1849 for the sum of 61 cents & 7 mills the amount of taxes interest and penalty due for the years 1847 & 1848 on five acres of land entered for taxation in the name of George Black - Also two acres of land sold by Silas A. Giesel Treasurer of Lake County to Thomas Lloyd January 10th 1833 for the sum of 63 cents & 6 mills the amount of taxes interest and penalty due for the years 1831 & 1832 on three ²⁵/₁₀₀ acres of land - And one ²⁵/₁₀₀ acres of land sold by William Goodwood Treasurer of Lake County to Thomas Lloyd January 15th 1837 for the sum of one dollar 48 cents the amount of taxes interest and penalty due for the years 1833, 1834, 1835, 1836 on said one ²⁵/₁₀₀ acres of land bounded and described as follows beginning in the west line of said tract No 12 and at the North west corner thereof and running thence S ¹/₂ E fourteen chains & 10 links - thence N ¹/₂ E

10 chains and 70 links thence S ¹/₂ W fourteen chains & 10 links to the place of beginning excepting & reserving therefrom one acre of land bounded and described as follows beginning in the west line of said tract 40.12.7 chains and 42 links and the said tract, thence S ¹/₂ E 71 links to a post thence S ¹/₂ E 71 links to a post thence S ¹/₂ W three chains & 29 links to a post in the west line of said tract thence by said tract line S ¹/₂ E 2 ¹/₄ E two chains to the place of beginning making with this exception six acres of land.

Survey of a piece of land for W. A. Skinner commencing at the South East corner of land sold by said W. A. Skinner to John Dolan in the center of the Skinner Road, so called and running thence S ¹/₂ E 7 chains & 2 links to a post thence S ¹/₂ W 3 chains & 63 links to a post thence S ¹/₂ E 6 chains & 55 links to the center of said Skinner Road - thence along the center of said Road S ¹/₂ E 3 chains & 67 links to the place of beginning containing two ⁴⁵/₁₀₀ acres of land and being situated in tract No 3 in the Town of Painesville Lake County Ohio
