



Resurvey of North Ridge road in Madison  
 Beginning at a Stake in the County line of Lake  
 of Nelson Maltby House bears N. 32 3/4° E. 1, 3/4 dist  
 Terrace, from which the N. E. corner of A. J. Kings  
 Stone, from which a Hickory about 18 inches in  
 to a Stone, from which the N. E. corner of S. Hotchkiss  
 S. 27 1/2° W. 82 dist, thence N. 50 1/2° W. 55, chains 44 links
