For the purpose of locating lines

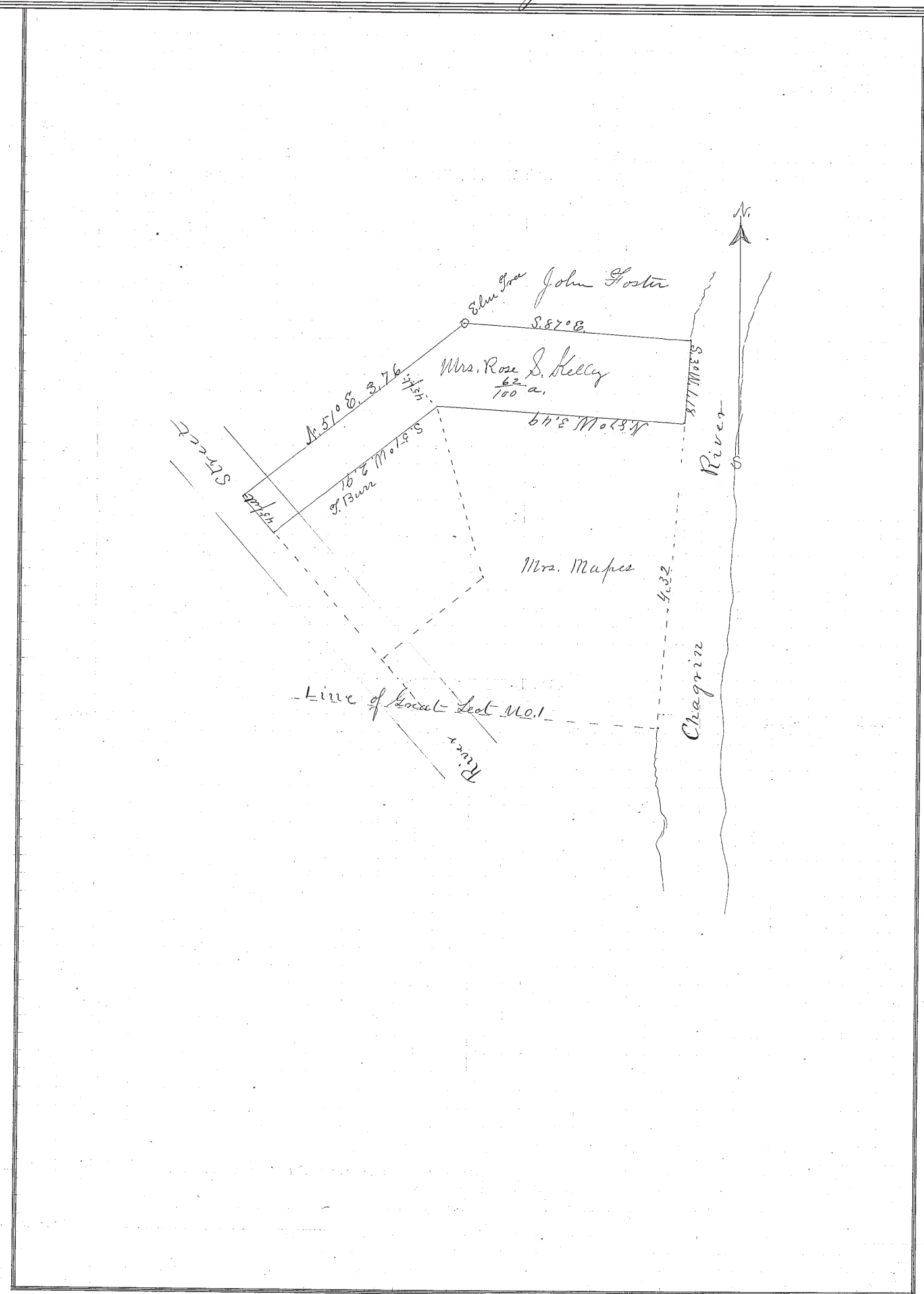

DESCRIPTION.

Survey of a part of Lot no. 47 of Willoughby Village.
Beginning in the center of River Street at the North West corner of Lot (formerly owned by J. Burr) being 3 chains and 29 links along said River Street from the South line of Great Lot No. 1
Thence with the center of River Street N. 42° W. 45 feet thence parallel with said Burr lot N. 51° E. 3 chains and 76 links to an Elm tree in the South line of John Foster's land, thence with said line S. 87° E. to the River, thence up the river S. 3° W. one chain and 18 links to the North line of Mrs. Mapes land, thence with said line N. 87° W. 3 chains + 49 links to a brick at the North East corner of said Burr lot, thence with the North line of said lot S. 51° W. 2 chains + 91 links to the place of beginning.
Containing $\frac{62}{100}$ acres of land.
