Plat of Survey, No. 136, Painesville Town 11, Range 8

Survey made January 15th 1881, at the request of C. J. Scott & Harley Barnes
 For the purpose of Subdividing into lots, parts of Lots 11-16+19 of Tract No
 Four of Painesville Township, by H. N. Munson County Surveyor.

DESCRIPTION.

Beginning at a stake on the east side of Newell St. or Shed road so called four rods from the north line of A. Buttons land measured at right angles there to. Thence along the east line of Newell or Shed road N. 15 1/2° W. 19 chains + 89 links to a stake in the south line of a proposed street, one chain and 6 links from the South West corner of 10 acre owned by E. S. Withers measured on the east line of said Newell Street. Thence on the south line of said proposed street, N. 48 1/2° E. 5 chains + 57 links to a stake parallel with + 63 feet distant from said E. S. Withers's south line. Thence parallel with said Newell street or Shed road S. 15 1/2° E. 24 chains + 2 links to a stake in a line four rods north of A. Buttons land. Thence parallel with said Buttons north line N. 8 1/2° W. 5 chains + 25 links to the place of beginning. Containing 10 7/100 acres of land.
