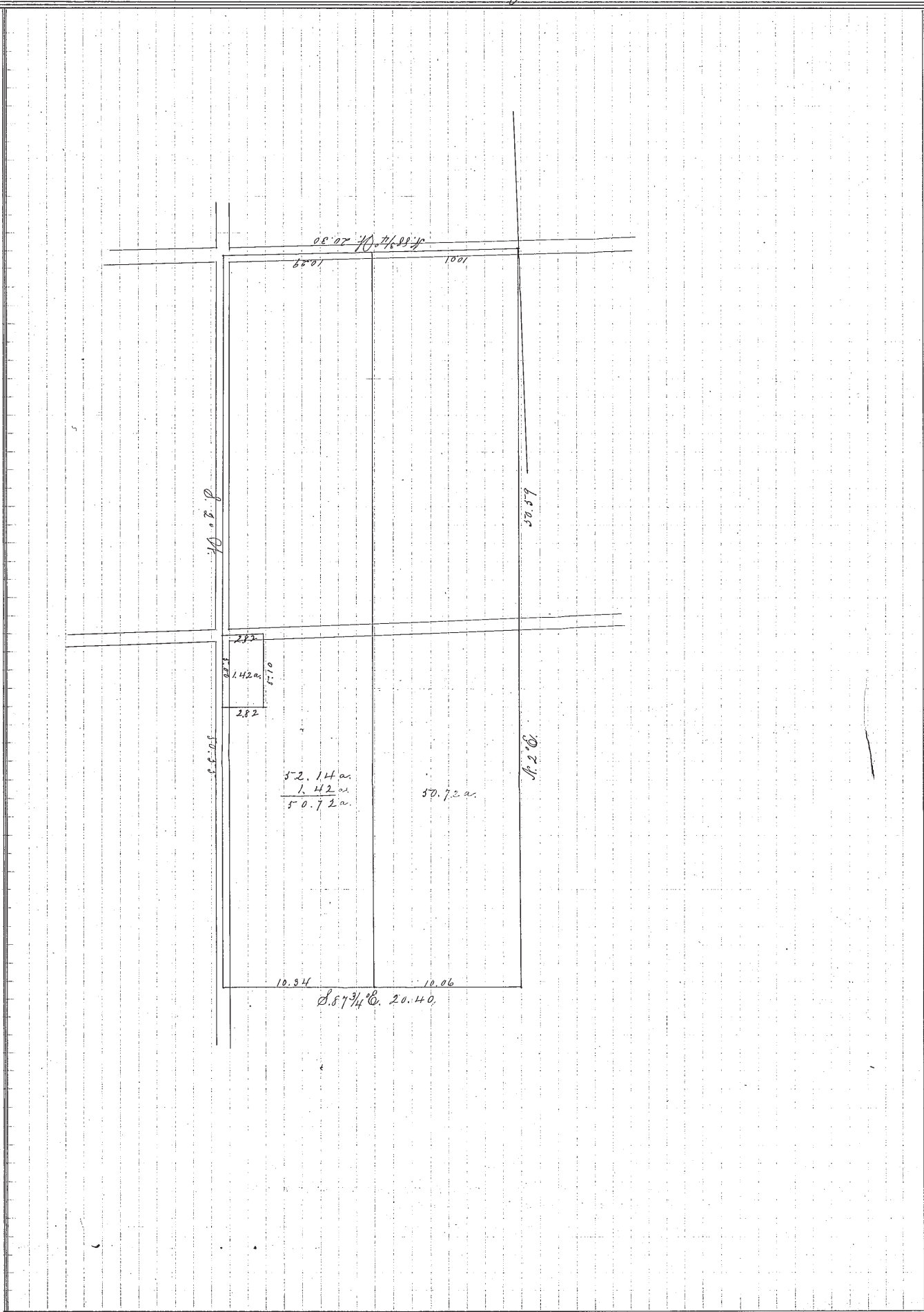
Plat of Survey, No. 140, Willoughby Town 9, Range 10

Beginning at the Northwest corner of Lot No. 2, Tract No. 3, Willoughby township, thence with the West line of said Lot, S. 2° W. 50 chains & 55 links to the Southwest corner of said Lot, thence with the South line of said Lot, S. 87 3/4° E. 20 chains & 40 links to a stone in the Southeast corner of said Lot, thence with the East line, N. 2° E. 50 chains & 57 links, to the Northeast corner of said Lot, thence with the North line of said Lot, N. 88 3/4° W. 20 chains & 30 links to the place of beginning.
