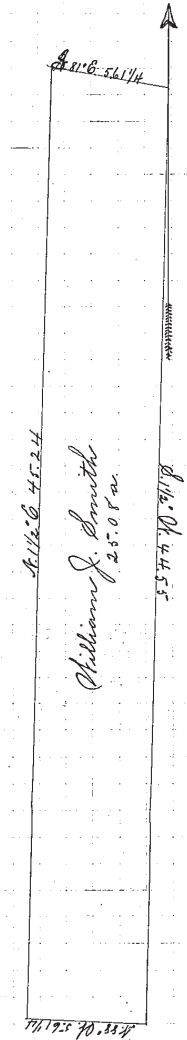

DESCRIPTION.

Beginning in the center of the road, in the East line of said Lot, thence with said Lot line, S. 1 1/2° W. 44 chains + 55 links, to the South-east corner of said Lot, thence with the South line of said Lot, N. 88° W. 5 chains 6 1/4 links to a stake, thence N. 1 1/2° E. 45 chains + 24 links to the center of the road, thence with the center of the road, 5 chains, 6 1/4 links to the place of beginning, containing 25.08 a.
