Plat of Survey, No. 196 Lroy & Concord Town 3 10 + 10, Range 748
 Survey made June 8th + 9th 1882, at the request of Co. Commissioners
 For the purpose of locating line of Old Plank Road through Lroy & Concord township
 by H. A. Morrison County Surveyor.

DESCRIPTION.

Survey of Old Plank Road in Lroy and Concord townships - Beginning in the east line of Lroy township at a stake in the center of the road and 38 feet from the south line of said road where three stones are placed in said lines - the 38 ft being measured at right-angles with south line of road. Thence along the center of said road N. 86 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° W. 23.78 chains to a stake thence N. 80 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° W. 22.40 chains to a sandstone from which the south west corner of Emery Sprague's house bears N. 9° E. 65 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. distant. Thence N. 84 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° W. 11.37 chains to a stone marked thus + in front of R. C. Potts' house - Thence S. 88 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 8.57 chains to a stake. Thence N. 65 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. (at 4.00 chains Warren's creek) 11.52 chains to a stake at the center of the road leading to Thompson center. Thence S. 80° W. (at 2.36 chains set stakes for 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ mile on north side of road) 30.00 chains to a stake. Thence N. 82 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. (at 2.50 chains center of Nichols road at 6 chains center of Coal road) 10.00 to a stake. Thence N. 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. (at 29.64 chains center of McMillin creek) 31.50 chains to a stake. Thence N. 61 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. (at 10.86 set 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ mile stake on north side of road near E. Callow) 36.44 chains center of N. + S. Center road at Brakeman's meeting house 44.15 chains to a stake where the Old Plank road leaves the Gridded road. Thence N. 37 $\frac{1}{4}$ ° W. (at 26.71 chains set 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ mile stake, at 54.70 chains McMillin creek, at 104.80 chains center of New Road, at 106.71 chains marked a pine tree 14 in. in diameter in front of Fred Ray's house for 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles) 145.76 chains to a stake at south side of stone culvert at Woods' corners and in center of Carter road. Thence N. 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 2.30 chains to a stake in center of the east and west Center Road. Thence N. 64 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. (at 33.40 chains of stone culvert on Williams and Adams creek at 38.65 chains set 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ mile stake near Don Williams' gate to Woods lot) 68.58 chains to east line of Concord township. Thence N. 87° W. (at 28.06 chains center of road leading to Carter's corners, at 37.90 chains center of Huntington Road) 50.07 to stake at 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ mile a little west of Geo Baker's house. Thence N. 79 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 4.70 chains to center of stone Culvert. Thence N. 74° W. 4.73 to a stake in line with the west end of Carlos Baker's house. Thence N. 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. (at 31.87 chains of stone culvert) 41.00 to a stake soon with a large white ash tree in front of Mrs. Clapp's barn. Thence N. 71° W. 29.36 chains to a stake about 2 rods East of the east line of the Stickney Cemetery. Thence N. 56° W. (21 links set 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ mile stake) 4.00 chains to a stake. Thence N. 32 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° W. (at 10.00 chains road past Stickney to Hays Mills) 16.00 chains to a stake. Thence N. 61 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 4.00 chains to a stake. Thence N. 79 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 3.00 chains to a stake. Thence

Thence North 5.00 chains to a stake. Thence N. 87 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. (at 8.21 chains set 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ mile stake) 8.94 chains to a stake in the south line of Painesville township, from which an old apple tree stump said to be on the lower line bears S. 81 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet distant. Whole distance run. 8 miles + 73 chains.
