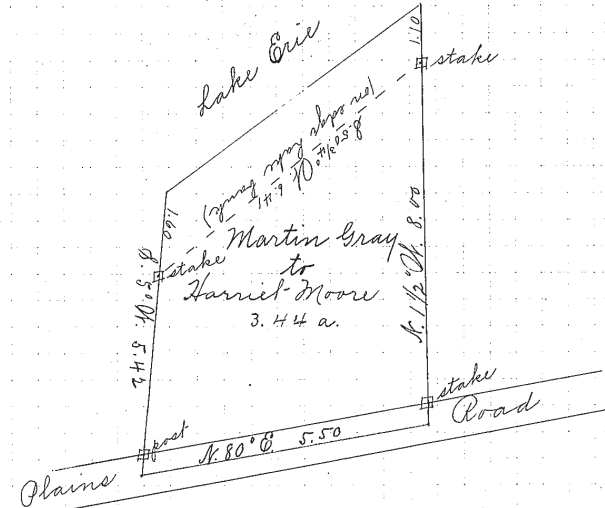

DESCRIPTION.

Survey of land in Northwest part of Lot No. 1, Douglass Tract, Willoughby township conveyed by Martin C. Gray to Harriet Moore, June 24th 1892.
Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Douglass Tract, in the South shore of Lake Erie, thence with the West line of said Tract, S. 5° W. 5 chains and 42 links, to the center of the Plains Road, thence with said Road N. 80° E. 5 chains and 50 links, thence N. 1 1/2° W. 8 chains, to Lake Erie, thence along the South shore of said Lake, Southwesterly, to the place of beginning, containing 3 4/10 a. of land.
