DESCRIPTION.

Surveyors Report to County Commissioners

To The Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Lake Co Ohio
 I obedience to a verbal order from your honorable Board, I proceeded on the 22nd day of June 1899 to resurvey a County Road. Beginning at a point from which the SW corner of the Maple Grove Grange Hall bears 12 3/4° E 71 1/2 feet, which is also the intersection of the E line of River Road this point being the west line of Road to be resurveyed. Thence S 20° E four (4) chains + one (09) to the north line of land owned by W. J. Traver. Thence S 44 1/2° E six (6) chains + ten (10) links to a stake. Thence S 25 1/2° E six chains (6) and Ten (10) links to a post. Thence S 44 1/2° E six (6) chains + thirty two (32) links to the north line of Center Road for more minute details see plat annexed.

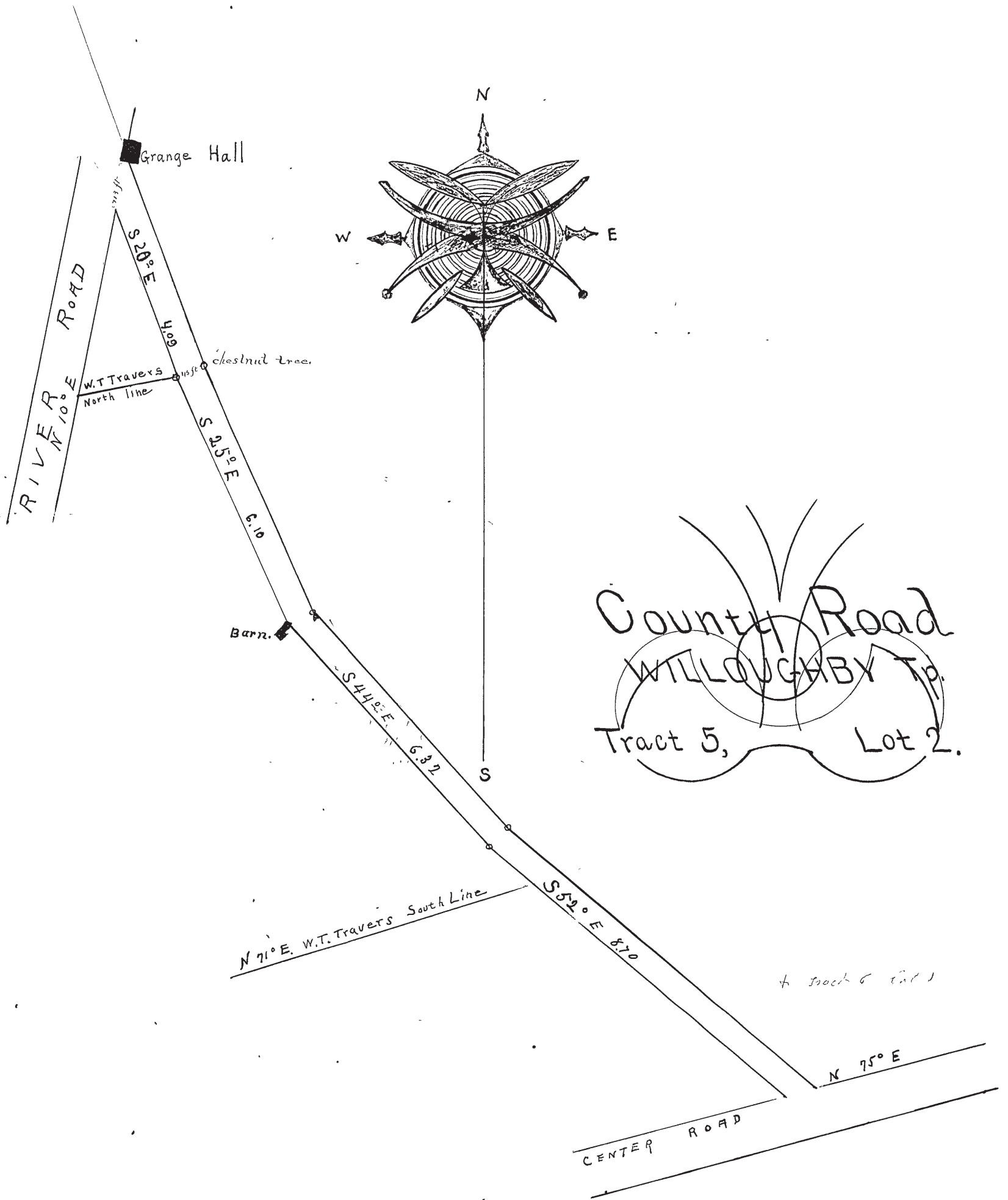
