DESCRIPTION. Given above

Surveyors Report to Board of Commissioners of Lake County Ohio.
 The undersigned, in obedience of your order dated June 24 A.D. 1900, proceeded on the
 27th day of June, to survey + mark the (3) three County Roads described in said
 order, under the directions of the viewers therein named, and respectfully submits the
 following return of said survey. We took for our initial point a stone monument on the
 West Side of High St + the South side of seventh St (Fairport Village, from this point by
 course + distances we layed out + marked the west end of said Roads as described
 in your order. We also found a stone monument on (2nd) Second St at the west line
 of land owned by Chas A. Woodley from which we located the eastern terminal of
 said Roads, we also drove gas pipe at each end of said roads on each side (30) thirty
 feet from the center of each road. see plat. for more minute details
