DESCRIPTION.

Beginning at a point where the road running east from Lane Station intersects the south line of the right of way land of the Cleveland, Painesville and Ashtabula Railway Company thence westerly on the south line of said right of way land to a post on the east line of the road running south from Lane Station; thence along the east line of said last named road to a gas pipe stake 60 feet distant at right angles westerly from said south line of the C. P. and A. Ry company's right of way land; thence north easterly and parallel with the said C. P. and A. company's south line 26 chains and 23 links (26.23) chs. to a gas pipe stake in the south line of said road running east from Lane Station; thence westerly along the south line of said last mentioned road to the place of beginning.
