DESCRIPTION.

*Taken from report of Viewers*  
 Under our directions the said surveyor located the point of intersection of said plank road with the north line of Bayou Street as the same was adjudged and decreed by the Circuit Court of said County in the action of Mary Payne Bingham et al. vs. the P.P. and F. R.R. Co. et al. - See Circuit Court Final Record No 1 at page 372 et seq. - Thence we found said plank road to run in a right or straight line south easterly a distance of 786.1 feet crossing the south line of Great lot 6 Tract 7. At a point 147.7 feet distant from said beginning point and 20.55 feet west of the intersection of the center line of high street extended south with said south line of lot 6.  
 At the end of said piece of straight road and at a point 638.5 feet from the intersection with the south line of lot 6 an angle is made to the right of 7°-18' and at this angle said road makes a 2° curve and we placed and set a gas pipe stake on the east side of said road 30' from the intersection of the center lines leading both ways from said angle.  
 From said angle we found the said road to run in a direct line to the center of the north end of the plank road bridge, the distance being 3720 feet. Except as following said circuit court decree we have determined the line as above described from the way the said road is and has been worked, improved, used and traveled and from occupation of a beltway lands by respective owners.
