DESCRIPTION.

At a meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Geauga County, June 7th 1815, it was ordered by the Board, that a certain part of the Township of Parisville, included in the following boundaries to wit:-

All that part of the Seventh Range and eleventh Town, that lays north of Grand River, be incorporated and erected into a separate Township, by name of Perry, hereafter to be, and remain as a separate and incorporated Township, with all the privileges and immunities thereto, by Law, appertaining. And also, that the electors meet at the house of Elijah Hauke in said Township of Perry on Saturday, the first day of July, next, at ten o'clock in the forenoon for the purpose of choosing Township Officers.
