**DESCRIPTION.**

Survey and division of a part of Lot No. 30, Tract No 1, Painesville township.  
 Beginning in the center of the road at the Northwest corner of Keller's land, thence with said line, S. 3° W., 22 chains and 28 links to the North line of the L. S. and M. S. Ry, thence with said line, N. 87 1/4° W., 7 chains and 6 1/2 links, thence N. 3° E., 22 chains and 28 links, to the center of the road, thence with the road, S. 87 1/4° E., 7 chains and 9 1/2 links to the place of beginning containing 15.78 acres of land, which was divided equally between Gerald Tuttle and Benjamin Smith
