Surveyors Report to County Commissioners **DESCRIPTION.**

To The Honorable Board of County Commissioners.
 In obedience to your order dated June 4th 1897 I proceeded on the 25th day of June 1897
 To survey and mark the proposed location of a County Road described in the foregoing
 order under the direction of the Viewers therein named.
 Beginning at a point 145 feet east of the East end of the Bridge that spans the Chagrin
 River at what is known as Eagle Mills The Course being S 86 1/2° E. Thence N 52 1/4° E (426)
 One hundred & twenty six feet to a stone in the center of the center road so called
 and which is the N-E corner of land owned by Thomas Stuebke.
 We extended our point of angle (40) forty feet easterly from the approach of said Bridge, to avoid
 a wash out as is shown on the annexed plat.
